### ABSTRACT

New Health Insurance Scheme, 2021 for the Employees of Government Departments and other Organizations and New Health Insurance Scheme, 2022 for Pensioners/Family Pensioners – Empanelment of Accredited Hospitals – Approval of 55 additional hospitals, inclusion of Additional specialties in 42 hospitals and for deletion 4 hospitals based on the recommendations of the Accreditation Committee – Notified – Orders – Issued.

#### ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, Government have constituted the Accreditation Committee for empanelment of accredited hospitals consisting of the Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts as Head of the Committee, the Director of Medical and Rural Health Services and a representative of United India Insurance Company Limited as Members of the Committee for empanelment of accredited hospitals and also to monitor the quality of treatment for the employees of Government Departments and other organizations covered under New Health Insurance Scheme. Further, Sub-Committees were constituted at District Level consisting of Joint Director, Medical and Rural Health Services, Treasury Officer and a representative of United India Insurance Company Limited to assist the Accreditation Committee for empanelment of private hospitals in various Districts across the State under New Health Insurance Scheme.

- 2. In the Government Order second and fourth read above, orders have been issued for the implementation of New Health Insurance Scheme, 4 2021 for Employees and their eligible family members and New Health Insurance Scheme, 2022 for Pensioners / Family Pensioners to provide Health Care Assistance to the employees of Government Departments, Public Sector Undertakings, Statutory Boards, Local Bodies, State Government Universities, willing State Government Organizations / Institutions and their eligible family members and in the case of Pensioners, their spouse are covered with a provision to avail cashless assistance upto Rs.5.00 lakh (Rupees Five Lakh only) and an enhanced assistance of Rs.10 lakh has been allowed for specific illness like Cancer, for certain organ transplantations, etc., for a block of 4 years on selection of a suitable Public Sector Insurance Company through National competitive bidding. As per the Guidelines for implementation of New Health Insurance Scheme 2021 and New Health Insurance Scheme 2022 under Clause 9(2), all hospitals already accredited under New Health Insurance Scheme 2016/2018 shall automatically be deemed to be networked hospitals.
- 3. In the Government Orders third read above, orders have been issued for empanelment of 56 new additional hospitals, 1 hospital for name change, 1 hospital for address change and deletion of 2 hospitals under New Health Insurance Scheme, 2021. So far approved Hospitals under New Health Insurance Scheme, 2021/ New Health Insurance Scheme, 2022 is 1223 and 1221 respectively.
- 4. The Implementation procedures for New Health Insurance Scheme, 2021/ New Health Insurance Scheme, 2022 included as Annexure-A to the Government Orders second and fourth read above, provides for inclusion of additional list of approved hospitals and treatments / surgeries based on the report of the Accreditation Committee.
- 5. The Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts in his letter fifth read above has submitted proposal to include 56 new additional hospitals as approved network hospitals, additional specialties in 42 hospitals and for deletion 4 hospitals under New Health Insurance Scheme, 2021 for Employees and New Health Insurance Scheme, 2022 for Pensioners / Family Pensioners as recommended by the Accreditation Committee.
- 6. The Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts has proposed 56 new hospitals for empanelment under New Health Insurance Scheme. One hospital noted in Annexure I, vide Sl.No.49, Nellai Eye Care Institute, 102, B2-B3, South Mount Road, Near Lakshmi Mahal, Tirunelveli 627 006 has already been empaneled (Annexure I, Sl.No.39, C.No.231A, D.No.15A, of Annexure I, Nellai Eye Care Institute, 106, B2-B3, South Mount Road, Near Lakshmi Theatre, Tirunelveli 627 006) in Government order issued vide G.O.Ms.No.71, Finance (Health Insurance-I) Department, Dated: 21.03.2022. Considering this, Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts requested to include 55 hospitals under New Health Insurance Scheme except Nellai Eye care institution.
- 7. The Government, after careful consideration of the recommendations of the Accreditation Committee, have decided to include and approve 55 new additional hospitals as network hospitals, additional specialties in 42 hospitals and for deletion 4 hospitals under New Health Insurance Scheme,

2021 for Employees and their eligible family members and New Health Insurance Scheme, 2022 for Pensioners / Family Pensioners as detailed in the Annexure I, II and III to this order and issue orders accordingly.


