विषय: Prior sanction for holding an elective office under Rule 15(1)(c) of CCS(Conduct) Rules, 1964-reg.

महोदय/महोदया,

Reference is invited to Headquarters office Circular dated 03.02.2023, wherein *inter-alia*, it has been intimated that;

- i. Rule 15(1)(c) of the Central Civil Services (Conduct) Rules, 1964, lays that “*no Government servant shall hold an elective office, or canvass for a candidate or candidates for an elective office, in any body, whether incorporated or not except with the previous sanction of the Government*”.
- ii. As per Sl. No. 13, Section F of the CAG’s Manual of Standing Order Volume II, the power to grant such permission lies with the Comptroller & Auditor General of India.
- iii. As per the DoP&T OM dated 27.02.2020, *a Government servant may be allowed to hold elective office in any body, whether incorporated or not, for period of two terms or for a period of 5 years, whichever is earlier, for which prior sanction would be required when a Government servant contests an election in such body, as per existing rules.*

2. The Department of Personnel and Training (DoP&T), vide its Office Memorandum No. 11013/1/2016-Estt.A-III dated 19.12.2025 (copy enclosed), while reiterating its earlier instructions issued vide aforesaid OM dated 27.02.2020 has now intimated that instances have come to its notice that a few senior officers of Central Government Ministries/Departments continue to hold positions of an elective nature in various institutions/bodies **without the mandatory prior sanction** of the Government under Rule 15(1) (c) of the CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964. Accordingly, DoP&T has instructed that the contents of above referred instructions may be brought to the notice of all officers/officials.

3. In view of the above, all Heads of Departments of IA&AD are requested to ensure strict compliance with the aforesaid instructions. Any violation of the aforesaid provisions may be dealt strictly in accordance with the extant provisions as given in CCS (Conduct) Rules 1964.


OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Prior sanction for holding an elective office under Rule 15(1)(c) of CCS(Conduct) Rules, 1964—reg.

The undersigned is directed to say that as per Rule 15 (1) (c) of the CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964, no Government servant shall except with the previous sanction of the Government, hold an elective office, or canvass for a candidate or candidates for an elective office, in any body, whether incorporated or not.

2. In this context, this Department vide OM No.No.11013/1/2016-Estt.A-III dated 27.02.2020 (copy enclosed) has issued guidelines wherein it is stated that a Government servant may be allowed to hold elective office in any body, whether incorporated or not, for period of two terms or for a period of 5 years, whichever is earlier, for which prior sanction would be required when a Government servant contests an election in such body, as per existing rules.

3. Instances have come to notice where a few senior officers of Central Government Ministries/Departments continue to hold positions of an elective nature in various institutions/bodies without the mandatory prior sanction of the Government under Rule 15 (1) (c) of the CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964. Accordingly, Ministries/Departments are, once again requested to kindly bring the contents of above referred instructions to the notice of all officers/officials and ensure strict compliance of these instructions.
