- (ii) The Welfare Officer has verified the information furnished in Form "A" by the applicant Shri Ankit Sewa, S/o Late Ravi Sewa Ex- Senior Auditor and has stated that the family is currently residing at Beharbari Quarter Complex (Qtr No. 162). Further, the applicant vide letter dated 20.11.2023 has declared that there is no immovable property in the names of the dependents of the deceased employee.(Affidavit enclosed)
- (iii) The Welfare Officer had verified the information furnished in Form "A" by the applicant Ms. Snigdha Bhattacharjee, W/o Late Bishnupada Bhattacharjee, Ex-Supervisor and had stated that the family had incurred expenditure for the treatment of the deceased employee by borrowing from relatives and friends, as the employee was under treatment for a long time, and a LIC housing loan amounting to Rs. 20,00,000/- was also the liability upon the family members of the deceased employee. Further, as per the letter received from Ms. Bhattacharjee on 16/11/2023, the approximate present value of her house (flat) is Rs. 28,40,000/-.
- (iv) The Welfare Officer has verified the information furnished in Form "A" by the applicant Shri Madhurjya Pratim Deka, S/o Late Manoranjan Deka, Ex- Asstt. Supervisor and has stated that the family had entered into an agreement for purchasing a flat approximate cost of which was Rs.31,00,000/- and also got permission from office wherein it is shown that Rs. 25,00,000/- would be managed from Bank Loan and Rs. 6,00,000/- from his personal savings. In this regard, the family member had stated to the Welfare Officer that the said flat has ultimately not been taken and accordingly the bank recovery has been stopped after death of Late Manoranjan Deka, and also stated that the said FLAT is going to be sold by the builder but no supporting documents in this regard was produced. Further, the family members are presently stated to be residing in their undivided three storied building located in land measuring to an area of 1 Katha 8 Lecha at Shantipur, Guwahati. Further, as per the letter received from Shri Deka on 21/11/2023, the approximate present value of the immovable property belonging to heirs of Late Manoranjan Deka is Rs. 36,75,000/-.
