State Judicial Officers-computation of Commuted Value of Pension reckoning the commutation factor applicable to State Service Sub: pensioners-reg

Ref: 1. GO(Ms) No.157/2006/Home dated 30.8.2006

As per Para 13 (iii) of the GO read as first paper above, issued in terms of the recommendations of Ist National Judicial Pay Commission, commutation of pension to the extent of 50% will be allowed to state Judicial Officers retiring with effect from 01.01.1996. Restoration of commuted portion of pension will be done only after 15 years. This will apply to all those who get the benefit of 50% commutation. As per GO referred as 2nd paper above, the pension benefits of State Judicial Officers have been revised again with effect from 1.1.2006 in terms of recommendations of the 2nd National Judicial Pay Commission.

As per item 4(b) of the Government letter referred as 3rd paper above, it was clarified that regarding commutation of pension, the revised table and the principle being followed for Central Civil pensioners will be adopted in the case of State Judicial Officers retired on or after 1.1.2006. As per GO read as 4th paper above, Government have issued general orders for recalculation of the Commuted Value of Pension (CVP) admissible to State Judicial Officers retired from service on or after 1.1.2006 applying the commutation factor 9.81 instead of the factor 8.194. In this context it is brought to the notice that the commutation factor 9.81 as per pre-revised commutation table can be applied only to those officers who retire from service at the age of 60 years (with age at next birthday 61 years). In the case of Judicial Officers who retire from service before attaining the age of 60 years (voluntary/invalid/compulsory retirement cases), the commutation factor to be applied is the factor corresponding to the age at next birthday following the date of retirement.

But irrespective of the rate of commutation factor applicable in the case of State Judicial Officers, where commutation of pension to the extent of 50% is allowed the restoration of commuted portion of pension will be done only after 15 years. Therefore, all pension dispursing officers are requested to kindly make necessary corrections, if ordered otherwise in the PPO/CPO issued in favour of retired State Judicial Officers from this office to the above extent, wherever necessary taking this Circular as authority and restore the commuted portion of pension on the expiry of 15 years from the date of effect of reduced pension after such commutation.
