

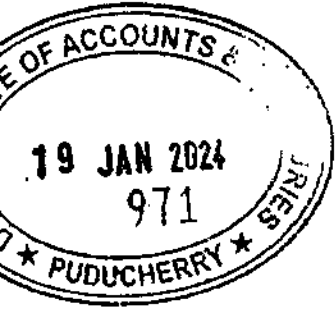

The Government of India have enhanced the existing rate of Dearness Relief on Pension / Family Pension from 42% to 46% of the Basic Pension/ Family Pension (including additional pension/family pension) with effect from 01/07/2023 in O.M.No.42/04/2023-P&PW(D), dated 27/10/2023 of the Government of India, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Department of Pension and Pensioners' Welfare, New Delhi.

The Government of Puducherry has communicated the Orders of Government of India for extending the revised rate of Dearness Relief @ 46% with effect from 01/07/2023 to the Pensioners / Family Pensioners of the Union Territory of Puducherry vide G.O. Ms. No.45/ FD/F3/ A2/2023-24, dated 31/10/2023 of the Finance Department, Puducherry.

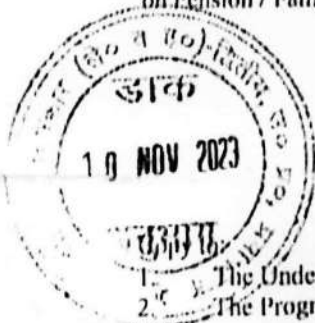



OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub: Grant of Dearness Relief to Central Government pensioners/family pensioners – Revised rate effective from 01.07.2023.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's OM No. 42/04/2023-P&PW(D) dated 06.04.2023 on the subject mentioned above and to state that the President is pleased to decide that the Dearness Relief admissible to Central Government Pensioners/Family Pensioners shall be enhanced from the existing rate of 42% to 46% of the basic pension/family pension (including additional pension/family pension) w.e.f 01st July, 2023.

2. These rates of DR will be applicable to the following categories:-

- (i) Civilian Central Government Pensioners/Family Pensioners including Central Govt. absorbee pensioners in PSU/Autonomous Bodies in respect of whom orders have been issued vide this Department's OM No. 4/34/2002-P&PW(D) Vol.II dated 23.06.2017 for restoration of full pension after expiry of commutation period of 15 years.
- (ii) The Armed Forces Pensioners/Family Pensioners and Civilian Pensioners/Family Pensioners paid out of the Defence Service Estimates.
- (iii) All India Service Pensioners/Family Pensioners.
- (iv) Railway Pensioners/Family Pensioners.
- (v) Pensioners who are in receipt of provisional pension.
- (vi) The Burma Civilian Pensioners/Family Pensioners and Pensioners/families of displaced Government Pensioners from Burma/ Pakistan, in respect of whom orders have been issued vide this Department's OM No. 23/3/2008-P&PW(B) dated 11.09.2017.

3. The payment of Dearness Relief involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.

4. Other provisions governing grant of DR in respect of employed family pensioners and re-employed Central Government Pensioners will be regulated in accordance with the provisions contained in Rule 52 of CCS (Pension) Rules, 2021 and this Department's OM No. 45/73/97-P&PW (G) dated 2.7.1999 as amended from time to time. The provisions relating to regulation of DR where a pensioner is in receipt of more than one pension will remain unchanged.

5. In the case of retired Judges of the Supreme Court and High Courts, necessary orders will be issued by the Department of Justice separately.

6. It will be the responsibility of the pension disbursing authorities, including the nationalized banks, etc. to calculate the quantum of DR payable in each individual case.

7. The offices of Accountant General and authorised Pension Disbursing Banks are requested to arrange payment of Dearness Relief to Pensioners/Family Pensioners on the basis of these instructions without waiting for any further instructions from the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Reserve Bank of India in view of letter No. 528-TA, II/34-80-II dated 23/04/1981 of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India addressed to all Accountant Generals and Reserve Bank of India Circular No. GANB No. 2958/GA-64 (ii) (CGL)/81 dated the 21st May, 1981 addressed to State Bank of India and its subsidiaries and all Nationalised Banks.

8. In so far as the persons serving in Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned, these orders are issued in consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India, as mandated under Article 148(5) of the Constitution of India.

9. This issues in accordance with the Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure's OM No. 1/4/2023-E.II(B) dated 20.10.2023

In the reference 4th read above, Government have revised rates of Dearness Relief to the pensioners/family pensioners, raising @ 3.144% from 27.248% of the basic pension/ family pension to 30.392% of the basic pension/ family pension w.e.f. 01.07.2018. Further the Government have decided to release the due Dearness Relief instalments in a time bound manner. Accordingly, orders were issued in the reference 5th read above with detailed instructions for revision of Dearness Relief (DR) to retired Pensioners/ Family pensioners of Government of Andhra Pradesh from 30.392% to 33.536% of basic pension / family pension w.e.f. 1st January, 2019.

2. In the reference 6th read above, orders were issued for the revision of the Dearness Relief sanctioned to the pensioners/family pensioners of Government of Andhra Pradesh from the rate of 33.536% to 38.776% of basic pension/ family pension w.e.f. the 1st July, 2019.
3. In the reference 7th read above, orders were issued for adoption of the decision of the Government of India for freezing of Dearness Allowance/Dearness Relief at the rates applicable on 01.01.2020, 01.07.2020 and 01.01.2021 for the State Government employees and Pensioners / family pensioners.
4. In view of reference 8th read above, the Government hereby order for release of all pending Dearness Relief (DR) instalments due from 01.07.2019 to 01.07.2021 (5 DR

14. In the event of death of any employee before the issue of these orders, the legal heir(s) shall be entitled to the arrears of Dearness Relief.

15. All the Treasury Officers/Pension Payment Officers shall ensure that the bills are supported by proper schedules in duplicate indicating the details pensioner/family pensioner in terms of orders issued in G.O.Ms.No.122, Finance (Pen.I) Department, Dt: 22.05.2014.

The Government of India, Ministry of Law and Justice, Department of Justice has appointed the Second National Judicial Pay Commission in pursuance of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, vide Resolution 4th read above to examine and make suitable recommendations relating to the pay structure and emoluments of Judicial Officers in the States and Union Territories, including pension and other post-retirement benefits and also to examine the work methods and work environment with a view to promoting efficiency in judicial administration. The said Commission submitted its report on interim relief on 09.03.2018 and the Hon'ble Supreme Court by order dated 27.03.2018 directed all the States to implement the recommendations of the Commission with regard to interim relief. Accordingly, Government of Andhra Pradesh sanctioned 30% interim relief to all the Judicial Officers, Pensioners vide reference 6th read above.

2. The Second National Judicial Pay Commission has submitted its report with regard to the pay, pension and allowances of the Judicial Officers to Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, in their orders, dated 27.07.2022 in W.P.(C) No.643 of 2015 directed all the States/UTs to implement the revision of pay structure of Judicial Officers as recommended by SNJPC with effect from 01.01.2016.

3. The Government in pursuance of the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, dated 27.07.2022 and in obedience thereof hereby order to implement the revised pay scales to the Judicial Officers w.e.f.01.01.2016 as recommended by Second National Judicial Pay Commission as follows:

d. Fixation of pay in the pay matrix in regard to migration/fitment of the serving judicial officers on 01.01.2016 as indicated in Table-II above is broadly based on the following points:

- i. Multiply the existing pay by the factor of 2.81.
- ii. The figure so arrived at to be located in Table-I in relation to the Level applicable to the Officer (i.e. J1, J2 etc.).
- iii. Where there is an identical figure available in Table-I at the corresponding stage of the relevant level, the new revised pay shall be fixed at that stage.
- iv. Where there is no identical figure available, the new revised pay has to be fixed at the very next higher stage in that level in Table-I.

e. Fixation of pay on promotion on or after 01.01.2016

For those who are promoted from the previous level to the next level, or granted financial upgradation/ACP or Selection Grade or Super Time Scale, the procedure for fixing the pay in the new pay matrix on such promotion/financial upgradation, will be as follows:

- i. Identify the level and the basic pay in Table-I on the date of promotion.
- ii. Add one increment in that level itself in terms of FR-22.
- iii. The figure so arrived at or the next closest figure in the level to which s(he) is promoted will be the new pay on promotion.

f. Increment

The annual increment shall be @ 3% cumulative meaning thereby that the increment @ 3% has to be calculated on the previous years basic pay instead of fixed amount increments recommended by FNUJC and JPC.

g. Dearness Allowance & other Allowances

Dearness Allowance shall be as admissible at the rates applicable to the Central Government employees drawing VII CPC Pay Scales. As regards the other allowances the amounts presently being drawn shall continue to be drawn pending further orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in that regard and subject to final adjustment.

h. Payment of Arrears

The arrears shall be computed with effect from 01.01.2016 and after adjusting the interim relief already paid, the balance amount shall be paid in stages in the following manner, subject to production of an undertaking in the Form appended to this order:

i.	25% in cash within a period of 3 months from 27.07.2022 i.e. from the date of the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
ii.	Another 25% to be paid in cash within 3 months thereafter; and
iii.	The balance 50% has to be paid on or before the end of June, 2023.

4. The Registrar, General, High Court of Andhra Pradesh shall take necessary further action in the matter accordingly.

No. 535-F (Pen) or 536-F (Pen) both dated 1/10/2019 and @ 151% payable to the pensioners/family pensioners who are drawing basic pension/family pension at the pre-revised rate i.e. in terms of their Memo. No. 200-F (Pen) or 201-F (Pen) both dated 25/2/2009, in supersession of the rates mentioned in the circular dated 17/3/2023.

Payment of relief on pension/family pension involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the nearest rupee in each case.

All Pension Disbursing Officers are, therefore, requested to make necessary arrangements for payment of dearness relief at the rates as contained in the enclosed memo. dated 3/1/2024 to all eligible West Bengal Govt. pensioners/family pensioners after proper adjustment.

In this context, it is reiterated that separate circulars will be issued with regard to grant of dearness relief on pension/family pension to the teaching and non-teaching pensioner/family pensioners of Non-Govt. MEMORANDUM

Sub : Grant of Dearness Allowance to State Government Employees and the employees of Government aided Educational Institutions, employees of Statutory Bodies, Government Undertakings, Panchayats including Panchayat Karmee, Municipal Corporations / Municipalities, Local Bodies etc. and also Dearness Relief to the Pensioners / Family Pensioners.

The question of enhancement of (i) Dearness Allowance in the revised pay structure implemented as per recommendation of the 6th Pay Commission in respect of Government employees, the teaching and non-teaching employees of Government aided Educational Institutions, employees of Statutory Bodies, Government Undertakings, Panchayats including Panchayat Karmee, Municipal Corporations / Municipalities, Local Bodies etc. and (ii) Dearness Relief on the pension / family pension since revised as per recommendation of the said Pay Commission has been under consideration of the Government for some time past.

2. After careful consideration, the Governor has been pleased to decide the following:

- I. The whole time State Government employees shall draw Dearness Allowance @ 10% of basic pay with effect from 01.01.2024. The calculation of Dearness Allowances shall be made taking into account the revised basic pay and NPA, if any, but it shall not include any other type of pay.
- II. The Dearness Allowance as sanctioned at (I) above in respect of State Government employees shall be admissible to the teaching and non-teaching employees of Government aided Educational Institutions, employees of Statutory Bodies, Government Undertakings, Panchayats including Panchayat Karmee, Municipal Corporations / Municipalities, Local Bodies etc. The respective Administrative Department may sanction the benefit of Dearness Allowance @ 10% of revised basic pay with effect from 01.01.2024 to the employees under their control without making any further reference to Group-P₂ of this Department.
- III.
 - (a) The State Government Pensioners / Family Pensioners shall draw Dearness Relief @ 10% of revised basic pension / revised family pension with effect from 01.01.2024.
 - (b) It will be the responsibility of the Pension Disbursing Authority to calculate the quantum of Dearness Relief on revised Pension / revised family Pension payable to each individual case.
 - (c) For the purpose of payment of Dearness Relief sanctioned herein, the Principal Accountant General (A&E), West Bengal, will issue authority to the Public Sector Banks in Kolkata and the Accountant General of other States.
 - (d) The Treasury or Sub-treasury Officers in this State will give effect to this order without the authority of the Accountant General (A&E), West Bengal.

- IV. The Dearness Relief as sanctioned at (III) (a) above for the State Government Pensioners / Family Pensioners shall also be admissible to the Pensioners / Family Pensioners of State aided Non-Government Educational Institutions, Statutory Bodies / Government Undertakings / Panchayats, Municipal Corporations / Municipalities, Local Bodies etc., who are in receipt of revised Pension / revised Family Pension as per recommendation of 6th Pay Commission. The respective Administrative Department may sanction the benefit of Dearness Relief @ 10% of revised Pension / revised Family Pension with effect from 01.01.2024 to the Pensioners / Family Pensioners concerned under their control without making any further reference to Pension Branch of this Department.
- V. (a) The rate of Dearness Allowance in respect of the employees mentioned in para (I) above who are drawing pay in the pre-revised pay structure as per recommendation of the 5th Pay Commission shall be enhanced from 141% to 151% with effect from 01.01.2024.
(b) The pensioners / family pensioners still drawing pre-revised pension / family pension (As per ROPA 2009) will get Dearness Relief @ 151% with effect from 01.01.2024 till their pension / family pension is revised.
- VI. The Dearness Allowance / Dearness Relief sanctioned herein shall be rounded off to the nearest rupee in each case.
- VII. In the case of Public Undertakings / Statutory Bodies, the additional expenditure for sanction of Dearness Allowance and Dearness Relief should be borne by such Undertakings / Bodies themselves out of their own resources or out of financial assistance provided to them in the budget and no additional financial assistance will be given to them on that account.
- VIII. There will be a further ad-hoc increase in the Daily Rate of Wages by Rs.22/- (Rupees Twenty Two) only with effect from 01.01.2024 for the daily rated workers under the Government whose wages are not regulated by any Statutory provisions like the Minimum Wages Act, etc.



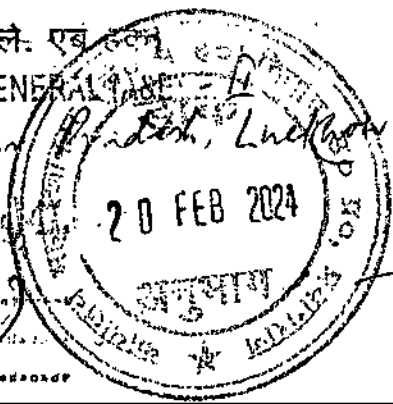

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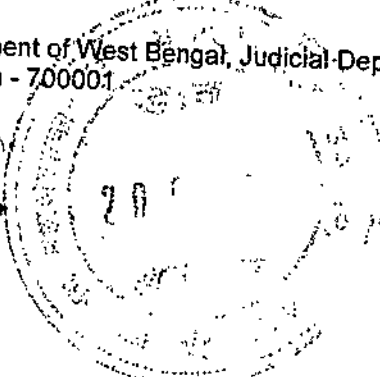
