I am to invite a reference to Government of Karnataka, Finance Department Order No. FD 19 SPP 2023, BANGALORE dated 21st October 2023, and to authorize you to pay DA at 38.75% (from 35 %) of the revised basic pension / family pension with effect from 01-07-2023, to the State Government pensioners/family pensioners of Karnataka including the pensioners/family pensioners of the Aided Educational Institutions whose pension/family pension is paid out of Consolidated Fund of the State.

These Orders are applicable also to the pensioners of UGC/AICTE/ICAR Scales of pay.

Separate Orders will be issued in respect of NJPC Pensioners.

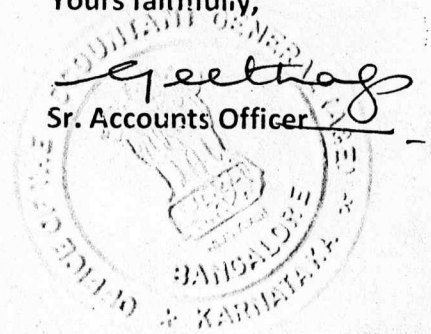

GOVERNMENT ORDER NO. FD 19 SRP 2023, BANGALORE, DATED 21th October 2023.

Government are pleased to enhance the rates of Dearness Allowance payable to the State Government Employees in the 2018 Revised Pay Scales from the existing **35% to 38.75% of Basic Pay** with effect from **1st July 2023**.

2. For the purpose of this order, the term 'Basic Pay' means, pay drawn by a Government Employee in the scale of pay applicable to the post held by him and includes:

- Stagnation increment, if any, granted to him above the maximum of the scale of pay;
- Personal Pay, if any, granted to him under sub-rule (3) of Rule 7 read with Rule 3(c) of the Karnataka Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2018;
- Additional increment, if any, granted to him above the maximum of the scale of pay.

3. Basic Pay shall not include any emoluments other than those specified above.

4. Government are also pleased to enhance the rates of Dearness Allowance from the existing 35% to 38.75% of the Basic Pension/Family Pension with effect from 1st July 2023 to the State Government Pensioners/Family Pensioners as well as Pensioners/Family Pensioners of the Aided Educational Institutions whose Pension/Family Pension is paid out of the Consolidated Fund of the State.

5. These orders are also applicable to Pensioners on UGC/AICTE/ICAR scales of pay.

6. These orders will apply to the full time Government Employees, Employees of Zilla Panchayats, Work Charged Employees on regular time scales of pay, full time Employees of Aided Educational Institutions and Universities who are on regular time scales of pay.

7. Separate orders will be issued in respect of Employees on UGC/AICTE/ICAR scales of pay and NJPC Pay Scale Judicial officers.

8. The increase in Dearness Allowance admissible under this order is payable in cash.

9. The payment on account of Dearness Allowance involving fractions of 50 paise and above shall be rounded off to the next rupee and fractions less than 50 paise shall be ignored.

10. The payment of arrears of Dearness Allowance shall not be made before the date of disbursement of salary for the month of October 2023.

11. The Dearness Allowance will be shown as a distinct element of remuneration and will not be treated as pay for any purpose.

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

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub:- Sanction of Dearness Relief (T.D) @ 4% enhancing the existing rate from 42% to 46% in favour of the State Government pensioners/ family pensioners with effect from 01.07.2023.

Government of India have released an additional instalment of Dearness Allowance to the Central Government Servants and Dearness Relief to the Central Government pensioners/ family pensioners increasing @ 4% over the existing rate of 42% to 46% of the basic pay/ pension with effect from 01.07.2023 as per the Cabinet decision on 18.10.2023.

2. In the meantime, one additional dose of Dearness Allowance @4% has been sanctioned in favour of the State Government employees enhancing Dearness Allowance from 42% to 46% with effect from 01.07.2023 vide Finance Department Office Memorandum No. 29447/F, dated 20.10.2023.

3. After careful consideration of the matter, the State Government have been pleased to decide that Dearness Relief (T.D) on pension/ family pension shall be paid to the State Government pensioners/ family pensioners at the same rate of 4% on the revised basic pension/ family pension and provisional pension with effect from 01.07.2023. With sanction of one dose of Dearness Relief (T.D) at the rate of 4% the Dearness Relief now payable on the revised basic pension/ family pension and provisional pension will be enhanced from 42% to 46% with effect from 01.07.2023.

4. The additional dose of Dearness Relief shall also be admissible on additional basic pension/ additional family pension available to the old pensioners/ family pensioners based on their age as indicated in this Department O.M. NO.28300/F dated 23.09.2017.

For the purpose of this Office Memorandum

1. Pension/family pension in the case of the pre-01.01.2016 retirees and where family pension was due prior to 01.01.2016 means the revised basic pension/revised basic family pension as the case may be in terms of Finance Department Office Memorandum No.28300/F dated 23.09.2017.

P.T.O.

- ii. Also in the case of pensioners who have retired after 01.01.2016 or where family pension is sanctioned for the first time after 01.01.2016 the pension/ family pension means the basic pension / basic family pension as the case may be sanctioned on retirement/death.

5. The additional dose of Dearness relief shall also be admissible to the pensioners/ family pensioners of Non-Government Aided Educational Institutions including Primary Schools under School and Mass Education Department and Non-Government Aided Educational Institutions under Higher Education Department.

6. Payment of Dearness Relief (T.D) involving fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.

7. Other provisions governing grant of Dearness Relief (T.D) to Pensioners such as regulation of Dearness Relief during employment/ re-employment and regulation of Dearness Relief where more than one pension is drawn will remain unchanged.
