OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub:- Sanction of Dearness Relief (T.I) @4% enhancing the existing rate from 38% to 42% in favour of the State Government pensioners/ family pensioners with effect from 01.01.2023.

Government of India, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions, Department of Pension and Pensioners' Welfare in their O.M. No. No.42/04/2023-P&PW(D) dated 01.04.2023 have enhanced the Dearness Relief admissible to the Central Government pensioners/ family pensioners from the existing rate of 38% to 42% of the basic pension family pension (including additional pension/ family pension with effect from 01.01.2023.

2. In the meantime, one dose of Dearness Allowance @ 4% has been sanctioned in favour of the State Government employees enhancing Dearness Allowance from 38% to 42% with effect from 01.01.2023 vide Finance Department Office Memorandum No 17237/F, dated 13.06.2023.

3. After careful consideration of the matter, the State Government have been pleased to decide that Dearness Relief (T.I) on pension/ family pension shall be paid to the State Government pensioners/ family pensioners at the same rate of 4% on the revised basic pension/ family pension and provisional pension with effect from 01.01.2023. With sanction of one dose of Dearness Relief (T.I) at the rate of 4%, the Dearness Relief now payable on the revised basic pension/ family pension and provisional pension will be enhanced from 38% to 42% with effect from 01.01.2023.

4. The additional dose of Dearness Relief shall also be admissible on additional basic pension/ additional family pension available to the old pensioners/ family pensioners based on their age as indicated in this Department O.M. NO.28300/F dated 23.09.2017.

For the purpose of this Office Memorandum

- i. Pension/family pension in the case of the pre-01.01.2016 retirees and where family pension was due prior to 01.01.2016 means the revised basic pension/revised basic family pension as the case may be in terms of Finance Department Office Memorandum No.28300/F dated 23.09.2017.
 - ii. Also in the case of pensioners who have retired after 01.01.2016 or where family pension is sanctioned for the first time after 01.01.2016 the pension/ family pension means the basic pension / basic family pension, as the case may be sanctioned on retirement/death.
5. The additional dose of Dearness shall also be admissible to the pensioners/ family pensioners of Non-Government Aided Educational Institutions including Primary Schools under School and Mass Education Department and Non-Government Aided Educational Institutions under Higher Education Department.
6. Payment of Dearness Relief (T.I) involving fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.

Vide.No.FIN/ROP/REL-08/87(Vol-II) dated the 26/10/10, standing order of release of Dearness Relief to the Nagaland State Government Pensioners/Family Pensioners as and when sanctioned by the Government of India without any further order from the State Government or authorization from the Accountant General has been kept in abeyance till further notice(vide Finance Department, Government of Nagaland Vide.No.FIN/ROP/REL-8/87(Vol-II) dated the 26/02/2016. In future, for Revision of Dearness Relief, separate authorization will be issued as and when the same is revised by the State Government of Nagaland.

You are therefore requested to make necessary arrangement to circulate the O.M. to all Treasuries/Sub-Treasuries/Public Sector Banks under your jurisdiction for payment of enhanced rate of Dearness relief.

Co-ordn/345/195 dated 12/3/2020, it is re-iterated to all concerned that Govt. of West Bengal has already extended the benefit of additional quantum of family pension on attaining 80 years of age and above on the basis of the date of birth of the family pensioner already recorded in the PPO. The Government, vide their Memo. No. 460-F (Pen) dated 20/5/2009 and 635 F (Pen) dated 14/7/2010 (duly circulated to all Pension Disbursing Authorities vide this office circular no. Pen. Co-ordn/300/156 dated 28/1/2010 and Pen. Co-ordn/300/92 dated 9/8/2010 respectively) have decided that in case age of the family pensioner is not available in the PPO, following documents would be accepted as proof of date of birth/age of the family pensioner for payment of additional quantum of family pension:-

- (i) Certificate of the School Final Examination or equivalent examination;
- (ii) Certificate from any doctor belonging to W.B. Health Services (WBHS);
- (iii) Voter's I.D. Card (EPIC) and
- (iv) PAN Card.

Now, the Government in their Finance Department, Pension Branch Memo. No. 444-F (Pen) dated 22/5/2023 (copy enclosed) has further decided to accept Aadhar Card as proof of age of the aged family pensioners in addition to the prevalent documents in this regard. Further, it is also to state that where the date of birth of family pensioner already accepted and recorded in the office of the Govt. of West Bengal and duly incorporated in PPO by this office, the date of birth is to be considered as final and cannot be changed on production of any of the above documents for payment of additional quantum of family pension.

All Pension Disbursing Officers, are, therefore, requested to make payment of additional quantum of family pension to the eligible family pensioners following the *modus operandi* explained above.

MEMORANDUM

Subject: Age proof certificate for payment of additional quantum of family pension on attaining 80 years of age in terms of F.D. Memo. No. 200-F(Pen) dated 25.02.2009 and F.D. Memo. No. 201-F(Pen) Dated 25.02.2009.

Consequent upon revision of pension and family pension under ROPA, 2019 vide No. 535-F(Pen) & 536-F(Pen) dated 01.10.2019, read with Memo. No. 681-F(Pen) dated 23.12.2019 it has been brought to the notice of the Government that many aged family pensioners do not possess School Final Examination or equivalent examination certificates. Moreover, obtaining certificates from WBHS doctor has not been possible for many such aged family pensioners.

2) After careful consideration of the same the Governor has now been pleased to prescribe that any one of the following documents shall be accepted as proof of date of birth/age for payment of additional quantum of family pension only on completion of 80 years and above-

- (i) Certificate of the Madhyamik Examination or equivalent examination.
- (ii) Certificate from any doctor belonging to W.B. Health Services (WBHS).
- (iii) Voter's I.D. Card (EPIC).
- (iv) PAN Card.
- (v) Aadhaar Card.

3) In case of different dates of birth in different Certificates mentioned above, the date of birth first recorded and accepted in the office of the Govt. of West Bengal for payment of family pension is final and cannot be changed on production of any of the Certificates mentioned above for payment of additional quantum of family pension.

4) This order issues with the partial modification of F.D. 460-F(Pen) dated 20.05.2009, Memo. No. 635-F(Pen) dated 14.07.2010, Memo. No. 535-F(Pen) dated 01.10.2019 read with provision 13 of F.D. Memo. No. 681-F(Pen) dated 23.12.2019 and Memo. No. 55-F(Pen) dated 21.10.2020.

5) This order shall take effect from the date of the issue.



Sub-Ex-gratia grant for the year 2022-23 to the pensioners/family pensioners of Ex-
Management Staff of North Bengal Medical College & Burdwan Medical College

It is informed that the Govt. of West Bengal Higher Education Department, Budget Branch in their Memo no.13-Edn(B)/IM-12/2008 dated 20/04/2008 have sanctioned ex-gratia grant for the year 2022-23, @Rs.2900/- (Rupees Two thousand nine hundred) only in lump per head to the pensioners of State Aided Universities including the holders of provisional pension who retired prior to 30/9/2022 and also the pensioners who retired or died after 30/9/2022 but prior to 1/9/2023 and whose basic pension plus relief on pension as on March 31st 2023 did not exceed 33,000/- (Rupees Thirty three Thousand) only and are not entitled to receive ad-hoc bonus.

The aforesaid benefit will also be admissible to the pensioner/family pensioner who retired/died in harness as Ex-Management Staff of North Bengal Medical College or Burdwan Medical College who opted for University Pension Rules and whose pension/family pension has been regulated either under G.O. No. 83-Edn(U)/84-Edn(U)/85-Edn(U) all dated 30/1/2000 or G.O. No. 464-Edn(U) dated 13/8/2010 (communicated under this office circular No.Pen.Co-ordn/258/Vol-II/228 dated 3/2/2012 and Pen. Co-ordn. /217/Vol-II/220 dated 21/12/2012).

The aforesaid benefit will not, however, be admissible to the pensioners/family pensioners who are entitled to get ad-hoc bonus and those who are employed/re-employed under any public sector undertaking/statutory bodies/Non-Govt. Educational Institution under the Govt. are in receipt of bonus or ex-gratia payment during the current financial year.

The payment of ex-gratia as sanctioned in the Memo may be made to the Muslim Pensioners/family pensioners immediately on receipt of this circular and other than Muslim Pensioners/Family pensioners, the payment in this regard may be disbursed in between 3rd October 2022 to 6th October 2022.

Accordingly, all Pension Disbursing Officers are requested to make necessary arrangements for payment of Ex-gratia @ Rs. 2900/- (Rupees Two thousand and nine hundred only) to all eligible pensioners/family pensioners who retired/died in harness as Ex-Management Staff of North Bengal Medical College or Burdwan Medical College and whose P.P.O.s bear the indication "University Pension Rules", subject to fulfilment of the conditions mentioned above.

The benefit is not admissible to those who are entitled to ad-hoc bonus sanctioned by the Government and those who are employed / re-employed under any Public Undertaking / Statutory Bodies / Non-Government Educational Institutions and are in receipt of bonus or ex-gratia payment in lieu thereof during the current financial year

3. All concerned Pension Disbursing Officers are, therefore, requested to allow ex-gratia grant @ Rs.2900/- (Rupees Two thousand nine hundred) only in lump per head.

4. The payment of ex-gratia as sanctioned in the Memo may be made to the Muslim Pensioners/family pensioners immediately on receipt of this circular and other than Muslim Pensioners/family pensioners, the payment in this regard may be made in between 3rd October 2023 to 6th October 2023.

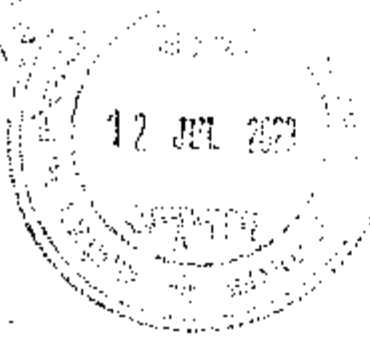

ORDER:

Government hereby order revision of the Dearness Relief (DR) sanctioned in the Government Order 8th read above to the Pensioners of Government of Telangana from 20.02% of basic pension to 22.75% of basic pension from 1st of January, 2022.

2. The above revision of Dearness Relief shall be applicable to;
 - a) The employees who retired from service on or after 01.07.2018 and are drawing pension as per the Revised Pay Scales, 2020.
 - b) The employees who retired before 01.07.2018 and whose pension was consolidated as per Government Orders issued vide reference 7th read above.
3. Government also hereby order revision of the Dearness Relief sanctioned vide reference 8th read above to the State Government Pensioners, who are drawing

pension in the Revised Pay Scales, 2015 from 55.536% to 59.196% of the basic pension from 1st of January, 2022.

4. Government hereby order revision of Dearness Relief from 31% to 34% of basic Pension from 1st January, 2022 in respect of the Pensioners who retired while drawing UGC/AICTE/SNJPC Pay Scales, 2016.
5. Government also hereby order revision of Dearness Relief from 196% to 203% of basic Pension from 1st January, 2022, in respect of the Pensioners who retired while drawing UGC/AICTE/FNJPC Pay Scales, 2006 and whose pension was not consolidated as per UGC Pay Scales, 2016.
6. These orders shall be applicable to;
 - a) All State Government Pensioners in receipt of Service Pensions, Family Pensions under Revised Pension Rules, 1951, Telangana (Andhra Pradesh) Liberalised Pension Rules, 1961, Telangana (Andhra Pradesh) Government Servants (Family Pension) Rules, 1964 and Revised Pension Rules, 1980.
 - b) Teaching and Non-Teaching pensioners of Municipalities, Panchayat Raj Institutions and Aided Educational Institutions, in receipt of pensions under the Telangana (Andhra Pradesh) Liberalised Pension Rules, 1961 and Telangana (Andhra Pradesh) Government Servants (Family Pension) Rules, 1964.
 - c) Teaching and Non-Teaching staff in Aided Educational Institutions in receipt of pensions under the Contributory Provident Fund-cum-pension and Gratuity Rules, 1961 and Telangana (Andhra Pradesh) Liberalised Pension Rules, 1961.
 - d) Those drawing family pensions as per Government Orders issued vide references 1st to 3rd read above.
 - e) Pensioners in receipt of compassionate pension under the rules for Compassionate Pensions and Gratuities in the Hyderabad Civil Services Rules.

In the Government orders 4th & 5th cited, orders were issued revising Dearness Allowance/ Dearness Relief to the State Government employees/ Pensioners from 01.01.2022.

2. The arrears on account of revision of Dearness Allowance for the period from 1st January, 2022 to 31st May, 2023 shall be credited into the General Provident Fund Account of the respective employees. However, in the case of employees who are due to retire on or before 31st Oct, 2023, the arrears of Dearness Allowance shall be drawn and paid directly as the employees due to retire on superannuation are exempted from making any subscription to the General Provident Fund during the last four months of service.

3. In respect of the employees who were appointed in-to Government service on or after 01.09.2004 and are governed by the Contributory Pension Scheme (CPS), 10% of the Dearness Allowance arrears from 1st January, 2022 to 31st May, 2023, shall be claimed and credited to the PRAN accounts of the individuals along with the Government share as per existing orders. The remaining 90% of Dearness Allowance arrears shall be paid in seventeen (17) equal monthly instalments commencing from the month of July, 2023.

4. In respect of Part Time Assistant, Village Revenue Assistants, Full Time Contingent employees, who are not eligible for GPF Accounts, the arrears shall be paid in the month of July, 2023.

5. The arrears on account of revision of Dearness Relief to pensioners for the period from 1st January, 2022 to 31st May, 2023 shall be paid in Seventeen (17) equal monthly instalments commencing from the month of July, 2023.
6. In the event of death of any employee/pensioner before the issue of these orders or **during the payment of instalments**, the legal heir(s) shall be paid the arrears of Dearness Allowance in lump sum.
7. All the Drawing Officers shall prefer the bill to the Pay & Accounts Officer, Hyderabad or to the Pay & Accounts Officer / Assistant Pay & Accounts Officer of the Telangana Works Accounts Service or to the District / Assistant / Sub Treasury of Officer, as the case may be, for the amount of arrears for the period from 1st January, 2022 to 31st May, 2023 to be adjusted to the General Provident Fund Account in the case of an employee who has opened a General Provident Fund Account.
8. The Drawing Officer shall ensure that the bills are supported by proper schedule in duplicate indicating details of the employee, the General Provident Fund Account, to be submitted to the Pay & Accounts Officers / District Treasury Officers/Assistant Pay & Accounts Officers or Pay & Accounts Officers of the Telangana Works Accounts Service, as the case may be. The Pay & Accounts Officer/Assistant Pay & Accounts Officer or Pay and Accounts Officer of the Telangana Works Accounts Service / District Treasury Officer / Assistant / Sub-Treasury Officer shall follow the usual procedure of furnishing one copy of the schedules along with bills to the Accountant General based on which the Accountant General shall credit the amounts to the General Provident Fund Accounts of the individuals concerned. The second copy of the schedules shall be furnished to the Drawing Officers with Voucher Numbers.
9. The expenditure on account of Dearness relief to pensioners is allocable among the various States in accordance with provisions of Rule-24 of the Incidence of Pension Rules in Appendix III-B of the Telangana Accounts Code, Volume-I.
10. All the Departments of Secretariat and Heads of Departments are requested to issue suitable instructions to the Drawing and Disbursing Officers under their control and to see that these instructions are followed scrupulously. The Director of Treasuries and Accounts / Director of Works Accounts / State Audit / Pay and Accounts Officer, Hyderabad are requested to issue suitable instructions to their subordinate offices so as to compliance these orders.



Sub: Grant of Dearness Relief to State Government Pensioners.

The Governor is pleased to order that the existing rate of Dearness Relief sanctioned vide Finance Department Order of even number dated 28-09-2022 to the State Government Pensioners who are in receipt of superannuation, retiring, invalid, compensation, family and extraordinary pension etc. shall be revised from 38% to 42% with effect from 01-01-2023.

For the purpose of this order -

- PA.
- (i) Pension/Family Pension in the case of pre-01-01-2016 retirees and where Family Pension was sanctioned prior to 01-01-2016, means the Revised Pension or Revised Family Pension, as the case may be, effective from 01-01-2016 in terms of Finance Department Memorandum No. F.12(6)FD(Rules)/ 2017 dated 30-10-2017 as amended vide Order No. F.12(6)FD(Rules)/ 2017 dated 09-12-2017 and F.12(6)FD(Rules)/ 2017 Pt.-I dated 06-06-2018.
 - (ii) In the case of pensioners who retire from service on or after 01-01-2017 or where family pension is sanctioned for the first time on or after 01-01-2017, Pension/Family Pension means the Basic Pension/Basic Family Pension, as the case may be, in terms of Finance Department Notification No. F.12(6)FD(Rules)/ 2017 dated 30-10-2017 as amended vide Order No. F.12(6)FD(Rules)/ 2017 dated 09-12-2017.
 - (iii) Dearness Relief will also be admissible on the additional quantum of pension / family pension allowed to the pensioners who have attained the age of 80 years and above.
 - (iv) Payment of Dearness Relief involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.
 - (v) Other provisions governing grant of dearness relief to pensioners' such as regulation of dearness relief during employment/re-employment, regulation of dearness relief where more than one pension is drawn etc., will remain unchanged.
 - (vi) This order shall also be applicable in case of Pensioners/Family Pensioners who are in receipt of provisional pension.

- (vii) This order shall not be applicable in case of Old Age Pensions, Political Pensions or any other kind of similar pensions, which are not related to the service rendered under Government.
- (viii) Dearness Relief at revised rates as above would also be admissible to pensioners who retired/are from service of Panchayat Samiti or Pta Parishad and whose Pension Payment Orders have been issued by the Director, Local Fund Audit Department or Director, Pension and Pensioners' Welfare Department, Rajasthan Jaipur.
- (ix) Cash payment shall be admissible from 01-01-2023.
