(ROP) Rules, 2017 shall be admissible as per rate shown below:

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued sanctioning the enhanced rate of Dearness Allowance to the State Government Pensioners / Family Pensioners as detailed below:-

2. In the Government Order second read above, orders were issued enhancing the rate of Dearness Allowance payable to State Government Employees and Teachers from 46% to 50% with effect from 1st January 2024.

3. Following the orders issued in the reference second read above, to the serving employees, the Government sanctioned the enhanced rate of Dearness Allowance to the State Government Pensioners / Family Pensioners as indicated below:

4. The arrears of Dearness Allowance for the months of January, February and March 2024 shall be drawn and disbursed by existing cashless mode of Electronic Clearance System (ECS). While working out the enhanced Dearness Allowance, fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to next higher rupee if such fraction is 50 paise and above and shall be ignored if it is less than 50 paise.

5. It will be the responsibility of the Pension Disbursing Authority to calculate the quantum of Dearness Allowance payable in each individual case.

6. Pending formal authorisation by the Principal Accountant General, the enhanced Dearness Allowance shall be paid straightaway by the Pension Pay Officer, Chennai-35 and Treasury Officers concerned.

7. This order will apply to the following categories of Pensioners:-

- (i) Government Pensioners, Teacher Pensioners of aided and local body educational institutions and other pensioners of local bodies.
- (ii) The State Government employees who had drawn lumpsum payment on absorption in Public Sector Undertaking / Autonomous Body / Local Body / Co-operative Institution and have become entitled to restoration of commuted portion of pension as well as revision of the restored amount.
- (iii) Present and future family pensioners; In the case of divisible family pensioners, Dearness Allowance shall be divided proportionately.
- (iv) Former Travancore-Cochin State pensioners drawing their pension on 1st November, 1956 in the Treasuries situated in the areas transferred to Tamil Nadu State on that date, i.e. Kanniyakumari District and Shencottai Taluk in Tenkasi District.
- (v) Pensioners who are in receipt of special pensions under Extra-ordinary Pension Rules, Tamil Nadu and Compassionate Allowance.

8. The expenditure on Dearness Allowance payable to the Pensioners and Family Pensioners shall be debited to the respective following Heads of Account:

"2071. Pension and Other Retirement Benefits -
01. Civil - 101. Superannuation and Retirement Allowances - State's Expenditure - AC. Dearness Allowance to Pensioners - 303 Dearness Allowance - 01. Dearness Allowance

10. The Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts, Chennai is requested to issue necessary instructions to Treasury Officers / Sub Treasury Officers and Pension Pay Officer while presenting the account bill on the enhanced rates of Dearness Allowance sanctioned as per 3 above.

11. The Treasury Officers / Pay and Accounts Officers are requested to make payment of the enhanced Dearness Allowance when bills are presented if it is found to be in order.

12. The increased expenditure due to the sanction of Dearness Allowance in this order is allowable among the outcrossed States as per the provisions laid down under the State Reorganisation Act, 1956.

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

New Health Insurance Scheme, 2021 for the Employees of Government Departments and other Organizations and New Health Insurance Scheme, 2022 for Pensioners/Family Pensioners covered under the scheme - Empanelment of Accredited Hospitals - Approval of the accreditation committee for removal of closed hospitals from the empanelled list - Deletion 34 hospitals based on the recommendations of the Accreditation Committee - Notified - Orders - Issued.

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ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, Government have constituted the Accreditation Committee for empanelment of accredited hospitals consisting of the Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts as Head of the Committee, the Director of Medical and Rural Health Services and a representative of United India Insurance Company Limited as Members of the Committee for empanelment of accredited

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hospitals and also to monitor the quality of treatment for the employees of Government Department and other organizations covered under New Health Insurance Scheme. Further, Sub-Committees were constituted at District Level consisting of Joint Director, Medical and Rural Health Services, Treasury Officer and a representative of United India Insurance Company Limited to assist the Accreditation Committee for empanelment of private hospitals in various Districts across the State under New Health Insurance Scheme.

2. In the Government Orders second and third read above, orders have been issued for the implementation of New Health Insurance Scheme, 2021 for Employees and New Health Insurance Scheme, 2022 for Pensioners / Family Pensioners to provide Health Care Assistance to the employees of Government Departments, Public Sector Undertakings, Statutory Boards, Local Bodies, State Government Universities, willing State Government Organizations / Institutions and their eligible family members and in the case of Pensioners, their spouse are covered with a provision to avail cashless assistance upto Rs.5.00 lakh (Rupees Five Lakh only) and an enhanced assistance of Rs.10 lakh has been allowed for specific illness like Cancer, for certain organ transplantations, etc., for a block of 4 years on selection of a suitable Public Sector Insurance Company through National competitive bidding. As per the Guidelines for implementation of New Health Insurance Scheme 2021 and New Health Insurance Scheme 2022 under Clause 9(2), all hospitals already accredited under New Health Insurance Scheme 2016/2018 shall automatically be deemed to be networked hospitals.

3. In the Government Order third read above, orders have been issued for empanelment of 56 new Additional hospitals, 1 hospital for name change, 1 hospital for address change and deletion of 2 hospitals under New Health Insurance Scheme, 2021.

4. In the Government Order fifth read above, orders have been issued for empanelment of 55 new Additional hospitals, Additional Specialties in 42 hospitals and deletion of 4 hospitals under New Health Insurance Scheme, 2021 for employees and their eligible members and New Health Insurance Scheme, 2022 for Pensioners / Family Pensioners.

5. In the Government Order sixth read above, orders have been issued for empanelment of 79 new Additional hospitals, Additional Specialties in 19 hospitals and deletion of 23 hospitals under New Health Insurance Scheme, 2021. So far approved Hospitals under New Health Insurance Scheme 2021/ New Health Insurance Scheme 2022 is 1330 and 1328 respectively.

6. The Implementation procedures for New Health Insurance Scheme, 2021/ New Health Insurance Scheme 2022 included as Annexure to the Government Orders second and fourth read above,

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provides for inclusion of deletion list of approved hospitals and treatments / surgeries based on the report of the Accreditation Committee.

7. The Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts, in his letter seventh read above has submitted proposal for deletion of 35 hospitals for effective implementation of the New Health Insurance Scheme 2021 for Employees and their eligible family members and New Health Insurance Scheme 2022 for Pensioners / Family Pensioners as recommended by the Accreditation Committee

8. The Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts has proposed deletion of hospitals under New Health Insurance Scheme. One hospital noted in Annexure-II, vide SLNo.1, Amrit Eye Surgery Centre, No.97/31A, Ormes Road, Kilpauk, Chennai-10 has already been deleted, vide G.O.Ms.No.71, Finance (Health Insurance-I) Department, Dated: 21.03.2023 due to name changed as Amrit Lasik and Eye Surgery Centre Egmore. Considering this, Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts has now requested to issue necessary orders for deletion of 34 hospitals under New Health Insurance Schemes except Amrit Eye Surgery Centre.

9. The Government, after careful consideration of the recommendations of the Accreditation Committee, have decided to delete 34 hospitals under New Health Insurance Scheme, 2021 for Employees and New Health Insurance Scheme, 2022 for Pensioners / Family Pensioners as detailed in the Annexure to this order and issue orders accordingly.



The Accreditation Committee is empowered to empower accredited hospitals and also to monitor the quality of treatment for the employees.

of Government Department and other organizations covered under New Health Insurance Scheme. Further, Sub-Committees were constituted at District Level consisting of Joint Director, Medical and Rural Health Services, Treasury Officer and a representative of United India Insurance Company Limited to assist the Accreditation Committee for empanelment of private hospitals in various Districts across the State under New Health Insurance Scheme.

2. In the Government Order second and fourth read above, orders have been issued for the implementation of New Health Insurance Scheme, 2021 for Employees and New Health Insurance Scheme, 2022 for Pensioners / Family Pensioners to provide Health Care Assistance to the employees of Government Departments, Public Sector Undertakings, Statutory Boards, Local Bodies, State Government Universities, willing State Government Organizations / Institutions and their eligible family members and in the case of Pensioners, their spouse are covered with a provision to avail cashless assistance upto Rs.5.00 lakh (Rupees Five Lakh only) and an enhanced assistance of Rs.10 lakh has been allowed for specific illness like Cancer, for certain organ transplantations, etc., for a block of 4 years on selection of a suitable Public Sector Insurance Company through National competitive bidding. As per the Guidelines for implementation of New Health Insurance Scheme, 2021 and New Health Insurance Scheme, 2022 under Clause 9(2), all hospitals already accredited under New Health Insurance Scheme 2016/2018 shall automatically be deemed to be networked hospitals.

Subject:- Grant of dearness relief on pension/family pension to the pensioners/ family pensioners(teaching & non-teaching) of State Aided Non Govt. Colleges w.e.f. 1/1/2024

In continuation to this office circular No. Pen.Co-ordn./51/Vol-VIII/204/Vol-II/4 dated 05/04/2023, it is stated that the Govt. of West Bengal, Higher Education Department, in the order no. JS(31)-Edn(U)/HED-12012(21)/2024-UNV SEC-Deptt.vof HE dated 11/1/2024 read with their clarificatory letter No. 280-Edn(CS)/10M-13/2024 dated 9/4/2024 have sanctioned dearness relief @ 10% with effect from 01/01/2024 on the basic pension/family pension, so revised as per Memo No. 210-Edn (CS) dated 14/02/2020 or Memo No. 234-Edn (CS) dated 14/02/2020, circulated under the office circular No. Pen. Co-ordn./204/Vol-II/198 dated 17/03/2020 and Pen. Co-ordn./204/Vol-II/157 dated 17/03/2020 respectively to the pensioners/family pensioners of the teaching and non-teaching staff of the State-Aided Non-Government Colleges in this State.

Besides, the pensioners/family pensioners arising out of teaching/non-teaching employees of State aided Non-Govt. Colleges, who are still drawing pre-revised pension/family pension as per ROPA2009, will get Dearness Relief @151% with effect from 01/01/2024 till their pension/family pension is revised.


All concerned Pension Disbursing Officers are, therefore, requested to allow dearness relief on revised rates of pension/family pension @ 10% and on un-revised rates of pension/family pension @151% with effect from 01/01/2024 to the above categories of pensioners/family pensioners.

Payment of dearness relief on pension/family pension involving a fraction of rupee shall be rounded off to the nearest rupee in each case.

Other provisions governing grant of dearness relief to the pensioners/family pensioners not mentioned in this order, such as regulation of relief during re-employment, regulation of relief where more than one pension is drawn etc., will remain unchanged.







The Governor is pleased to order that the existing rate of Dearness Relief sanctioned vide Finance Department Order of even number dated 31-10-2023 to the State Government Pensioners who are in receipt of superannuation, retiring, invalid, compensation, family and extraordinary pension etc. shall be revised from 45% to 50% with effect from 01-01-2024.

For the purpose of this order -

- (i) Pension/Family Pension in the case of pre-01-01-2016 retirees and where Family Pension was sanctioned prior to 01-01-2016, means the Revised Pension or Revised Family Pension, as the case may be, effective from 01-01-2016 in terms of Finance Department Memorandum No. F.12(6)FD(Rules)/ 2017 dated 30-10-2017 as amended vide Order No. F.12(6)FD(Rules)/ 2017 dated 09-12-2017 and F.12(6)FD(Rules)/ 2017 Pt-I dated 06-06-2018.
- (ii) In the case of pensioners who retire from service on or after 01-01-2017 or where family pension is sanctioned for the first time on or after 01-01-2017, Pension/Family Pension means the Basic Pension/Basic Family Pension, as the case may be, in terms of Finance Department Notification No. F.12(6)FD(Rules)/ 2017 dated 30-10-2017 as amended vide Order No. F.12(6)FD(Rules)/ 2017 dated 09-12-2017.
- (iii) Dearness Relief will also be admissible on the additional quantum of pension / family pension allowed to the pensioners who have attained the age of 80 years and above.
- (iv) Payment of Dearness Relief involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.
- (v) Other provisions governing grant of dearness relief to pensioners' such as regulation of dearness relief during employment/re-employment, regulation of dearness relief where more than one pension is drawn etc. will remain unchanged.
- (vi) This order shall also be applicable in case of Pensioners/Family Pensioners who are in receipt of provisional pension.



वित्त विभागीय संकल्प संख्या-9154, दिनांक-28/09/2022 एवं संकल्प संख्या-8649, दिनांक-28/07/2023 द्वारा बिहार न्यायिक सेवा के पदाधिकारियों को पुनरीक्षित वेतन एवं पेंशनादि लाभ की स्वीकृति प्रदान की गई है।

2. बिहार न्यायिक सेवा के पदाधिकारियों को माननीय सर्वोच्च न्यायालय, नई दिल्ली द्वारा सिविल ऑरिजनल/ इन्हेरेंट/एक्स्ट्रा-ऑर्डिनरी अपीलेंट जूरिस्ट्रीक्शन, रिट पिटीशन (सिविल) संख्या- 643/2015 (ऑल इंडिया जजेज एशोसियेशन बनाम यूनियन ऑफ इंडिया एवं अन्य) में दिनांक-04/01/2024 को पारित आदेश के आलोक में बिहार न्यायिक सेवा के पदाधिकारियों को भत्ता एवं सुविधाओं के पुनरीक्षण का विषय, राज्य सरकार के समक्ष विचाराधीन था।

3. सम्यक् विचारोपरान्त बिहार न्यायिक सेवा के पदाधिकारियों के लिए निम्नलिखित भत्तों की स्वीकृति प्रदान की जाती है :-

II.] गृह निर्माण अग्रिम :-

- गृह निर्माण अग्रिम आवास एवं शहरी कार्य मंत्रालय, भारत सरकार द्वारा निर्गत HBA Rules, 2017 के अनुरूप अनुमान्य होगा।
- निजी व्यक्तियों से बने बनाये मकान खरीदने हेतु आवश्यक प्रावधान, उच्च न्यायालय के परामर्श से राज्य सरकार द्वारा निर्गत किया जाएगा।

III.] शिशु शिक्षा भत्ता :-

- बिहार न्यायिक सेवा के पदाधिकारियों को शैक्षणिक वर्ष 2019-20 के प्रभाव से शिशु शिक्षा भत्ता प्रतिमाह ₹2,250/- एवं छात्रावास अनुदान ₹6,750/- प्रतिमाह अथवा वास्तविक खर्च, जो कम हो, की दर से अधिकतम दो संतानों हेतु बारहवीं कक्षा तक की शिक्षा के लिए अनुमान्य किया जायेगा।

- (b) दिव्यांग बच्चों के लिए उपरि कडिका में वर्णित दर के दोगुने दर भुगतान/प्रतिपूर्ति अनुमान्य होगा।
- (c) महंगाई भत्ता 50% होने पर उपरोक्त भत्ता एवं अनुदान में 25% की बढ़ोत्तरी की जाएगी।
- (d) शिशु शिक्षा भत्ता एवं छात्रावास अनुदान की प्रतिपूर्ति संस्थान के प्रधान द्वारा व्यय को अंकित करते हुए निर्गत प्रमाण-पत्र के आधार पर की जाएगी।

[III.] नगर क्षतिपूरक भत्ता:-

नगर क्षतिपूरक भत्ता अनुमान्य नहीं होगा। पूर्व में यदि उक्त मद में भुगतान हुआ हो, तो उसकी वसूली नहीं की जायेगी।

[IV.] अतिरिक्त प्रभार के लिए भत्ता (Concurrent Charge):-

- (a) यह भत्ता, 10 कार्य दिवस से अधिक के अतिरिक्त प्रभार वाले पद के वेतनमान के न्यूनतम प्रक्रम का 10% होगा।
- (b) उक्त सीमा के अधीन कार्य दिवस में किए गए न्यायिक एवं प्रशासनिक कार्य के आधार पर माननीय उच्च न्यायालय द्वारा न्यायिक पदाधिकारियों को मिलने वाले अतिरिक्त प्रभार के लिए (Concurrent Charge) भत्ता के सम्बन्ध में निर्णय लिया जाएगा।

[V.] वाहन/परिवहन भत्ता :-

- (a) पुल कार व्यवस्था समाप्त की जाती है। परन्तु, ऐसी सुविधा प्राप्त न्यायिक पदाधिकारी एक वर्ष की अवधि के लिए पुल कार सुविधा प्राप्त कर सकते हैं। ऐसी स्थिति में उन्हें परिवहन भत्ता अनुमान्य नहीं होगा।
- (b) बिहार न्यायिक सेवा के पदाधिकारी, जो अपने निजी वाहन का उपयोग सरकारी कार्य हेतु करते हों, उन्हें रख-रखाव एवं चालक हेतु रु० 10,000/- प्रतिमाह की दर से परिवहन भत्ता दिनांक-01/01/2016 के प्रभाव से अनुमान्य होगा। दिनांक-01/01/2021 के प्रभाव से यह दर रु० 13,500/- हो जायेगा। जिन पदाधिकारियों के पास अपना निजी वाहन नहीं है और वे पुल कार की सुविधा भी प्राप्त नहीं करते हैं, उन्हें भी उक्त दर से परिवहन भत्ता अनुमान्य होगा। पुनः जिन पदाधिकारियों को वाहन चालक के रूप में कार्यालय परिचारी उपलब्ध कराया गया है, उन्हें दिनांक-01/01/2016 के प्रभाव से रु० 4,000/- प्रतिमाह की दर से परिवहन भत्ता अनुमान्य होगा। दिनांक-01/01/2021 से यह राशि रु० 5000/- प्रतिमाह होगी। ईंधन भत्ता के अतिरिक्त यह लाभ देय होगा।

- (c) न्यायिक पदाधिकारी, जो अपने निजी वाहन का उपयोग सरकारी कार्य हेतु करते हों, को शहरी क्षेत्र हेतु 100 लीटर पेट्रोल/डीजल एवं अन्य क्षेत्रों हेतु 75 लीटर पेट्रोल/डीजल प्रतिमाह अनुमान्य हो सकेगा। यह प्रतिपूर्ति वास्तविक खपत के आलोक में स्व-प्रमाणन (Self-Certification) के आधार पर की जाएगी।
- (d) पूर्व से सरकारी वाहन की सुविधा प्राप्त कर रहे न्यायिक पदाधिकारियों की सूची में निदेशक, बिहार न्यायिक अकादमी अथवा न्यायिक प्रशिक्षण संस्थान/प्रधान न्यायाधीश, परिवार न्यायालय/सचिव, जिला विधिक सेवा प्राधिकार भी शामिल होंगे।
- (e) सरकारी कार्य हेतु सरकारी वाहन से की गई यात्रा हेतु ईंधन की अधिसीमा वास्तविक खपत के हद तक लॉग बुक एवं संबंधित अधिकारी द्वारा प्रमाणन के आधार पर अनुमान्य होगा। निजी उद्देश्यों के लिए सरकारी वाहन का उपयोग 300 किलोमीटर (प्रतिमाह) की अधिसीमा तक राज्य सरकार द्वारा निर्धारित दर पर किया जा सकेगा। सरकारी वाहन के निजी उपयोग की गणना अर्द्ध-वार्षिक आधार पर की जाएगी।
- (f) न्यायिक पदाधिकारी अपने वाहन के बायीं ओर मध्यम आकार के "जज" नामक स्टीकर का प्रयोग कर सकेंगे, जिसके सम्बन्ध में परिवहन विभाग द्वारा आवश्यक मार्ग-निर्देश निर्गत किया जायेगा।
- (g) न्यायिक पदाधिकारियों को 10 लाख रुपये की अधिसीमा तक सुलभ ब्याज दर पर मोटरकार खरीदने हेतु ऋण सुविधा (soft loan) उपलब्ध कराया जायेगा। इस संबंध में विस्तृत प्रावधान/प्रक्रिया वित्त विभाग द्वारा उच्च न्यायालय के परामर्श से निर्धारित किया जायेगा।

[VI.] महँगाई भत्ता :-

बिहार न्यायिक सेवा के पदाधिकारियों को केंद्र सरकार द्वारा समय-समय पर स्वीकृत दर के अनुसार महँगाई भत्ता अनुमान्य होगा।

[VII.] उपार्जित अवकाश नकदीकरण :-

न्यायिक पदाधिकारियों को उपार्जित अवकाश का नकदीकरण निम्न रूप से अनुमान्य होगा:-

- (a) L.T.C. का उपभोग करने के क्रम में, 10 दिनों के उपार्जित अवकाश का नकदीकरण, सम्पूर्ण सेवा अवधि में अधिकतम छः बार, कुल 60 दिनों के लिए अनुमान्य होगा।
- (b) दो वर्षों के ब्लॉक में 30 दिन के उपार्जित अवकाश का नकदीकरण अनुमान्य होगा।

- (c) उपर्युक्त (a) एवं (b) के अतिरिक्त, सेवानिवृत्ति के समय अव्यवहृत उपरोक्त अधिकांश का नकदीकरण 300 दिनों के अधिसीमा तक अनुमान्य होगा।
- (d) दिनांक-01/01/2016 के उपरान्त सेवानिवृत्त न्यायिक पदाधिकारी, जिन्हें उपरोक्त कठिनाई- (a) एवं (b) के अधीन अनुमान्य छुट्टी के नकदीकरण को सेवानिवृत्ति के समय छुट्टी नकदीकरण के विरुद्ध समायोजित किया गया हो तो उक्त समायोजित अधि या भुगतान संकल्प निर्गत होने के तीन माह के अंदर किया जाएगा।

[VIII.] विद्युत एवं जल शुल्क :-

- (a) राज्य न्यायिक सेवा के पदाधिकारियों द्वारा उनके आवास के लिए विद्युत एवं जल शुल्क के रूप में किये गये मासिक भुगतान का 50% की राशि की प्रतिपूर्ति, प्रास्ताविक अभिश्रव के विरुद्ध की जायेगी।
- (b) जल एवं विद्युत के उपभोग की अधिसीमा निम्नवत् होगी:-

उपर्युक्त संशोधित दर दिनांक- 01/01/2020 से प्रभावी होगी।

[IX.] उच्चतर शिक्षा भत्ता :-

न्यायिक सेवा के पदाधिकारियों को विधि में स्नातकोत्तर की उपाधि प्राप्त करने पर तीन अग्रिम वेतन-वृद्धि एवं पीएच०डी० की उपाधि प्राप्त करने पर एक अतिरिक्त अग्रिम वेतन-वृद्धि का लाभ अनुमान्य होगा। नियुक्ति के पूर्व उपरोक्त उपाधि धारित करने की स्थिति में यह लाभ नियुक्ति की तिथि से तथा सेवा अधि में उपरोक्त उपाधि प्राप्त करने पर, उपाधि प्राप्ति की तिथि से अनुमान्य होगा। एक बार अग्रिम वेतन-वृद्धि प्राप्त करने के बाद किसी अन्य विषय में स्नातकोत्तर या डॉक्टरेट डिग्री के लिए अग्रिम वेतन-वृद्धि अनुमान्य नहीं होगा। अग्रिम वेतन-वृद्धि नियमित एवं डिस्टेन्स लर्निंग प्रोग्राम से प्राप्त डिग्री, दोनों मामलों में प्राप्त होगा।

[X.] होम अर्बली / घरेलू सहायता भत्ता :-

बिहार न्यायिक सेवा के कार्यरत पदाधिकारियों को दिनांक-01/01/2016 के प्रभाव से निम्न दर से घरेलू-सह-कार्यालय सहायता भत्ता अनुमान्य होगा :-

- (a) जिला जज- राज्य सरकार द्वारा अकुशल श्रमिक के लिए निर्धारित मासिक न्यूनतम पारिश्रमिक जो, रु० 10,000/- प्रतिमाह से कम न हो।

- (b) शिविल जज- राज्य सरकार द्वारा अकुशल श्रमिक के लिए निर्धारित मासिक न्यूनतम पारिश्रमिक का 60%, जो रु० 7,500/- प्रतिमाह से कम न हो। घरेलू कार्य के लिए जिन्हे परिचारी की सेवा उपलब्ध है, उन्हें उपरोक्त भत्ता अथवा परिचारी की सेवा, में से एक का विकल्प देना होगा।
- (c) मिष्ठान न्यायिक सेवा के पेशनर एवं पारिवारिक पेशनरों को क्रमशः रु० 9,000/- प्रतिमाह एवं रु० 7,500/- प्रतिमाह की दर से दिनांक-01/01/2016 के प्रभाव से घरेलू पहायता भत्ता अनुमान्य हो सकेगा। यह भत्ता दिनांक- 01/01/2021 के प्रभाव से 30% के बर्द्धित दर से अनुमान्य होगा।
- (d) यह भत्ता स्व-प्रमाणन के आधार पर भुगतये होगा।

[XI] मकान किराया भत्ता :-

- (a) जिन न्यायिक सेवा के अधिकारियों को सरकारी आवास आवंटित है, वे मकान किराया भत्ता के हकदार नहीं होंगे।
- (b) माता-पिता/पति-पत्नी या स्वयं के घर में रहने वाले न्यायिक पदाधिकारी हेतु अनुशंसित मकान किराया भत्ता, दिनांक-01/01/2016 के प्रभाव से अनुमान्य होगा। इसके लिए उन्हें उच्च न्यायालय से अनुमति प्राप्त करनी होगी। वैसे पदाधिकारी, जो पूर्व से ही किराये के मकान में रहते हैं, उन्हें दिनांक-01/01/2020 के प्रभाव से वास्तविक किराया की प्रतिपूर्ति निर्धारित अधिसीमा के अन्दर प्राप्त होगा।
- (c) वैसे न्यायिक पदाधिकारी, जो किराये के मकान में स्व-प्रयास से रहते हैं, के मकान किराये (HRA की निर्धारित अधिसीमा तक) का भुगतान संबंधित प्रधान न्यायाधीश एवं समकक्ष द्वारा सीधे मकान मालिक को किया जायेगा। ऐसे मामलों में संबंधित न्यायिक पदाधिकारी को मकान किराया भत्ता की प्रतिपूर्ति अनुमान्य नहीं होगी।
- (d) केन्द्र सरकार द्वारा अधिसूचित मकान किराया भत्ता, O.M. No. 20/5/17-E दिनांक-07/07/2017 न्यायिक पदाधिकारियों के मामले में लागू होगा। मकान किराया भत्ता निम्न दर से शहरों के वर्गीकरण के आधार पर अनुमान्य होगा:-

- (a) न्यायिक सेवा के पदाधिकारी को प्रत्येक पाँच वर्ष पर रु० 1.25 लाख का फर्नीचर अनुदान वास्तविक अभिश्रव प्रस्तुत करने पर अनुमान्य होगा। जिन पदाधिकारियों की सेवानिवृत्ति हेतु सेवा-अवधि दो वर्ष से कम न हो, वे भी इस अनुदान के पात्र होंगे। उक्त अनुदान से घरेलू विद्युत उपकरण भी खरीदे जा सकते हैं। अधिकारी द्वारा उपयोग किये जा रहे फर्नीचर को राज्य सरकार द्वारा निर्धारित मूल्य ह्रास दर पर खरीदने का विकल्प नये अनुदान या सेवानिवृत्ति के समय उपलब्ध होगा।
- (b) फर्नीचर अनुदान के अलावा, प्रत्येक न्यायिक अधिकारी के आवास पर हर पाँच साल में एक बार एयरकंडिशनर (राज्य सरकार द्वारा निर्धारित अधिसीमा तक) वास्तविक अभिश्रव के आधार पर प्रदान किया जायेगा।
- (c) मकान किराया भत्ता एवं निजी आवास/क्वार्टर/अतिथि गृह-सह-ट्रांजिट होम के संबंध में विस्तृत आदेश अलग से वित्त विभाग द्वारा सम्बन्धित विभाग के परामर्श से निर्गत किया जाएगा।

[XII] एल०टी०सी० / एच०टी०सी० :-

- (a) न्यायिक अधिकारियों को 03 वर्षों के ब्लॉक में एक LTC एवं एक HTIC की अनुमति दी जा सकेगी। नव-नियुक्त न्यायिक पदाधिकारियों को प्रथम तीन वर्षों के ब्लॉक में दो HTIC अनुमान्य होगा। ब्लॉक वर्ष की गणना परिवीक्षा अवधि के समाप्ति के उपरांत की जायेगी।
- (b) सभी कोटि के न्यायिक पदाधिकारी को LTC हेतु हवाई यात्रा अनुमान्य होगी। इस हेतु टिकट की खरीदगी सरकार द्वारा निर्धारित एजेन्सी अथवा सीधे वायुयान कंपनी से की जानी होगी तथा यात्रा की श्रेणी/अग्रिम आदि राज्य सरकार द्वारा निर्धारित शर्तों के अधीन अनुमान्य होंगी।

- (c) न्यायिक पदाधिकारी बकाये LTC का उपयोग सेवानिवृत्ति के उपरान्त एक वर्ष की सीमा के अन्तर्गत करेंगे।
- (d) LTC स्वीकृत करते समय 10 दिनों की अर्जित छुट्टी का नकदीकरण (अधिकतम 60 दिनों के अधीन) अनुमान्य होगा। यह सेवानिवृत्ति के समय 300 दिन और दो वर्ष के ब्लॉक में 30 दिनों के नकदीकरण के अतिरिक्त होगा। इस सुविधा का उपभोग करते समय उपार्जित अवकाश के प्रारम्भ एवं अन्त में से एक अवसर पर दो आकस्मिक अवकाश जोड़ा जा सकेगा।

चिकित्सा प्रतिपूर्ति के संबंध में आवश्यक प्रावधान किये जाने हेतु स्वास्थ्य विभाग द्वारा अलग से सक्षम प्राधिकार की स्वीकृति प्राप्त की जाएगी।

- (b) यह प्रतिपूर्ति अर्द्ध-वार्षिक आधार पर जनवरी से जून एवं जुलाई से दिसम्बर के लिए स्व-प्रमाणन (Self-Certification) के आधार पर अनुमान्य होगा।
- (c) यह दर दिनांक-01/01/2020 से प्रभावी होगा।

[XV.] पोशाक भत्ता :-
