Pursuant to Government Resolution of even number dated 26.02.2026, the rate of Dearness Relief admissible to State Government Pensioners / Family Pensioners has been revised from 55% to 58%. Accordingly, a decision was taken to pay the said Dearness Relief in cash with effect from February 1, 2026, and to pay the arrears for the period from July 2025 to October 2025 in cash in the month of March 2026. Furthermore, it was decided that separate orders would be issued regarding the arrears for the remaining period (November 2025 to January 2026).

In line with this, the matter of paying the arrears for the remaining period to the State Government Pensioners / Family Pensioners was under the consideration of the Government.

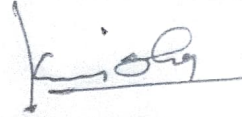

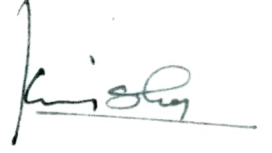
