

dated 27.07.2022 and 18.01.2023, Government issued Orders vide G.O. 4th read above for revision of pay structure of State Judicial Officers w.e.f. 01.01.2016 as recommended by the Second National Judicial Pay Commission (SNJPC) and also for payment of arrears in a phased manner.

- 2. Further, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in WP (Civil) No.643/2015, while considering the recommendations of the SNJPC relating to Pay, Pension, Gratuity, Service conditions etc., of State Judicial Officers accepted most of the recommendations and issued Orders dated 19.05.2023 directing that the revised rates of pensions, which have been approved by the Supreme Court, shall be payable from 01.07.2023. For the payment of arrears of pensions, additional pension, gratuity and other retiral benefits as well, it is directed that 25% will be paid by 31.08.2023, another 25% by 31.10.2023, and the remaining 50% by 31.12.2023.
- Government, after careful consideration of the recommendations of the SNJPC and the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 19.05.2023 hereby Order that:
 - the pension of retired Judicial Officers who retired prior to 01.01.2016 would be 50% of the last drawn pay of the post held at the time of retirement.
- the revision of pension shall be (a) Multiplier factor of 2.81 applicable for pension; or (b) Pensioners fitted at appropriate level in the fitment table (appended to this Order) whichever is higher.
- Judicial Officers who retired prior to 01.01.2016 to be placed notionally at the corresponding stage.
- iv. Family pension @30% will be paid to the eligible family member (s) as given in Rule 54 of Central Civil Services (Pension) Rules 1972 at par with the spouse, after the death of the spouse.
- v. The quantum of family pension be worked out in the same manner as quantum of pension is worked out.
- vi. Additional quantum of pension on completion of age of and at the rates specified will be paid as under:-

Age of Pensioner / Family Pensioner	Additional Quantum of
75-80 years	pension / family pension
80-85 years	20%
85-90 years	30%
90-95 years	40%
95-100 years	60%
On completion of 100 years	80%
or 200 years	100%

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- The revised rates of pension shall be payable from 01.07.2023. For payment of arrears of pension, additional pension, gratuity and other retiral benefits as well, it is ordered that 25% will be paid by 31.08,2023, enother 25% by 31.10,2023, and the remaining 50% by 5 31.12.2023.
- 5. The Registrar General, High Court for the State of Telangana, is requested to take necessary further action accordingly.

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The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in their orders dated 4th January 2024 has Issued directions with respect to the allowances payable to the Judicial Officers, retired Judicial Officers and Family Pensioners as recommended by the Second National Judicial Pay Commission:

2. Accordingly, in partial modification of the orders issued in GOs 1st to 8th read above, Government, in due compliance with the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, dated 4th January, 2024, accord sanction of the following allowances payable / reimbursable to the Judicial Officers, with effect from 1st January, 2016 or with effect from the dates mentioned under the respective allowances/ grant, as the case may be.

I. House Building Advance (HBA):

- a) HBA shall be made available to Judicial Officers in terms of HBA Rules, 2017 issued by the Government of India in O.M. dated 09-11-2017
- b) House Building Advance shall be made available to Judicial Officers also for the purchase of a ready built house from private individuals subject to
 such safeguards as may be prescribed by the State Government in consultation with the High Court.

Children Education Allowance (CEA) and Hostel Subsidy:

 a) Judicial Officers shall be entitled for Children Education Allowance with effect from the academic year 2019-2020;



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- b) They shall be entitled to to 2,250/- per month or actual fee paid, which ever is less as Children Education Allowance and Re 6,750/- per month or actual fee paid whichever is less, as heated subsidy for two children up to Class 12th
- c) For children with special needs, the reinjurisument would be at double the rate stated in sub-clause (b))
- d) When the DA Increases by 50%, the Children Education Allowance and Healer subsidy shall be increased by 25%; and
- e) Reimbursement will be done just once in every year; after completion of the academic year. For reimbursement of COA, a cartificate from the flead of Institution, where the ward of Judicial Officer studies, will be sufficient for this purpose. The cartificate should confirm that the child studied in the school during the previous academic year. For Hostel Subsidy, a similar contitionte from the Head of the Institution will suffice, with the additional requirement that the certificate should mention the amount of expenditure incurred by the Judicial Officer towards lodging and bearding in the residential complex. The amount of expenditure mentioned, or the ceiling as mentioned above, whichever is lower, shall be paid to the Judicial Officer.

III. City_Componsatory_Allowanco.(CCA);

City Compensatory Allowanda is discontinued prospectively. However, there shall not be any recovery of the amount already paid on account of the said allowance.

IV. Concurrent Charges Allowance:

- a) The Concurrent Charge Allowance shall be paid maximum at the rate of 10% of the minimum of the scale of the additional post held beyond a period of ten working days.
- b) No upward revision in the percentage of the Concurrent Charge
- c) High Court has to decide the Concurrent Charge allowages payable to the Judicial Officer within the celling of 10% on the basis of the number of days worked, the quantum of judicial work turned out and the administrative work handled
 - d) The criterion fald down by FNJPC is dispensed with and there shall not be any insistence on the performance of appreciable judicial work of the Court concerned."

V. Conveyance/Transport Allowance (TP)

- a) The pool car service for various Judicial Officers, as recommended by FNJPC, is dispensed with. However, if the officers wish, they can forgothe transport allowance and continue with the pool car service for a period of one year or so;
- b) The Transport Allowance at the rate of Rs 10,000/- per month with effect from 01/01/2016 shall be paid to those Judicial Officers who own the car so as to cover the cost of maintenance and driver's salary. This allowance will be increased to Rs 13,500/- from 01/01/2021. The Transport Allowance would be payable at a reduced rate of Rs 4,000/- per month if there is an existing practice of allocating a driving-knowing office attendant/open to the officer:

- c) In addition to the Transport Allowance, there should be a reimbursement of the cost of 100 litres of petrol/diesel in cities and District Head quarters including GFIMC limits and Municipal Corporations and 75 litres of petrol/diesel in other areas.
- d) The following Judicial functionaries are eligible for official vehicles, namely, Principal District Judge, Chief Judicial Magistrate/Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Principal Judge of City Civil Court, Principal Judge of Small Causes Court, Director of the Judicial Academy/Judicial Training Institute, Principal Judge of the Family Courts and Secretary of the District Legal Services Authority. The High Court for the State of Telangana can prune down the list depending upon budget allocation by the State Government;
- e) The quantum of petrol/ diesel for official cars is raised to the actual consumption for official purposes as certified by the concerned official and supported by a log book, which would be maintained. The Judicial Officers using official cars are permitted to use them for private purposes to the extent of 300 kms. per month;
- f) The Judicial Officers are permitted to exhibit a sticker at their option on the lower left side of the windscreen with inscription 'Judge' printed in moderately sized letters; and
- g) Soft loan facilities to the extent of rupees ten lakhs at nominal rate of interest for the purchase of car is extended to the Judicial Officers as per existing norms.
- h) The above said convenience/increase of fuel allowance shall not be admissible to those Judicial officers who are using official vehicle.
- i) The Judicial Officers are entitled for arrears of maintenance of car-cumdriver salary of Rs.10,000/- with effect from 01/01/2016 and Rs.13,500/with effect from 01/01/2021.

Earned Leave Encashment: VI.

- a) No enhancement in the maximum limit of 300 days leave encashment at the
- b) A Judicial Officer is entitled to encash;
 - 10 days earned leave while availing LTC subject to maximum 60 days (i) 10 days at a time upto six occasions during the entire service. (ii)

30 days in a block of two years.

- S.No.(i) and (ii) shall be in addition to the right of the Judicial (iii) Officers to encash up to 300 days EL at the time of retirement and 15 days of regular surrender leave per year.
- c) In case of officers who have retired and while granting leave encashment at the time of retirement, the leave encashment availed during service stand adjusted shall be paid the amount of the so adjusted earned leave, at the time of retirement.

VII. Electricity and Water Charges:

a) No change in the percentage of reimbursement. The 50% of reimbursement formula as provided at point 1 in the GO 1st read above shall continue.

b) The celling in terms of units of electricity and the quantity of water consumed shall be as follows:

District Judges	8000 PA	420 kls PA	
Civil Judges	6000 PA	336s PA	

- c) Reimbursement of electricity and water charges shall be on quarterly basis on production of proof of payment of the billed amount.
- d) This allowance shall be available at the enhanced rates w.e.f. 01/01/2020.

VIII. <u>Higher Qualification Allowance:</u>

a)

- (i) The Judicial Officers shall continue to draw advance increments for acquiring higher qualification i.e. post-graduation in law in terms of orders issued in GOs 4th and 6th read above.
- (ii) One more advance increment is payable to those Judicial Officers who acquired Doctorate in Law.
- b) The advance increments once granted for post-graduation degree or Doctorate in law shall not be again granted if, in future, the officer acquires post graduate or Doctorate degree in any other subject.
- c) The advance increments shall be available to the officer who had acquired the post-graduation degree or Doctorate either before recruitment or at any time subsequent thereto while in service.
- d) The advance increments shall be granted from the date of initial recruitment, if the officer has already acquired the post-graduation degree or Doctorate and from the date of acquiring the post-graduation or Doctorate degree, if acquired after joining the service.
- e) The advance increments shall be made available to all the officers.
- f) The benefit of advance increments shall also be extended at the ACP stage (ACP I or II). The advance increments shall be available when the Officer is promoted from Civil Judge (Jr. Div.) to Civil Judge (Sr. Div.) and from Civil Judge (Sr. Div.) to District Judge cadre.
- g) The advance increments shall be available in the District Judge Cadre from District Judge (Entry Level) to District Judge (Selection Grade) and from District Judge (Selection Grade) to District Judge (Super Time Scale).
- h) The advance increments for all practical purposes shall be part of salary and Dearness Allowance is also admissible on the same.
- i) The difference of arrears of advance increments and DA are admissible w.e.f 01/01/2016.

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IX. Home Orderly/Domestic Help Allowance:

 a) The Home-cum-office orderly allowance shall be available to the serving Judicial officers at the following rates

District Judges:

Minimum wages for one unskilled worker in Telangana State subject to minimum of Rs.10,000/- per month.

Civil Judges:

60% of the minimum wages for one unskilled worker in the Telangana State subject to minimum of Rs.7,500/- per month.

- b) The allowance at the aforesaid rates shall be available to the Judicial Officers w.e.f. 01/01/2016 if they are getting the same prior to 01/01/2016 and in other cases, w.e.f. 01/01/2020.
- c) The Judicial officers provided with Class-IV (Group-D) employee as an Attender/Peon/Office Subordinate for residential duties may exercise their option either to continue with the present system and forego the above allowance or to claim the allowance instead of availing the services of the official Attender/Peon/Office Subordinate.

d)

- (i) The payment of home orderly allowance should not result in discontinuance of practice, if any, of deputing the Office Peons/Attenders or other Group-D employee during nights at the residences of (i) Magistrates who are called upon to attend the Judicial work at times during night times. (ii) the Office Peon/Attender or such other Group-D employee deputed for night duty at the residence of Judicial Officer living in the areas generally considered to be disturbed or security risk areas or outsourced security guards to be deployed in such areas and (iii) such personnel can also be deputed to the residence of Principal District Judge or equivalent rank officer having administrative responsibilities.
- (ii) The deployment of Peons/ Attenders for such residential duties shall be subject to the availability of Group D/Class IV personnel and without detriment to Court related duties.

X. <u>Domestic Help Allowance:</u>

- a) Domestic Help Allowance to the pensioners and family pensioners is available at the following rates from 01/01/2016:
 - (i) Pensioner: Rs.9,000/- per month;
 - (ii) Family pensioners: Rs.7,500/- per month.
- b) This allowance shall stand increased by 30% on completion of five years from 01/01/2016 i.e., w.e.f. 01/01/2021.
- c) The allowance shall be drawn on the self-certification of the Judicial Officer/Pensioner/Family Pensioner.

XI. <u>Leave Travel Concession (LTC) / Home Travel Concession (HTC):</u>

 a) Encashment of 10 days earned leave while availing LTC (not HTC) (subject to the maximum of 60 days) can continue.

- (i) As regards frequency of LTC, the Judicial Officers are permitted to b) avail one LTC and one FITC in a block of 3 years.
 - (ii) As far as fresh recruits are concerned, the HTC is allowed 2 times in the first block of 3 years. However, the block of 3 years will commence on completion of the period prescribed for probation (not necessarily declared).

c)

- The Judicial officers irrespective of their rank are allowed to travel by air and the reimbursement shall be made subject to the condition (i) that the tickets have been purchased either directly from the Airlines or from the authorized agents, namely, Ashoka Travels, Balmer and Lawrie and IRCTC by the Central/State Government subject to further addition or deletion of the authorized agent by the Central/State Government.
- The other details such as class of travel, advance etc. shall be (ii) governed, by the Rules/Orders of States applicable to its Officials / employees.
- d) The Judicial Officers are allowed to carry forward LTC anywhere in India beyond retirement for a period of one year.
- e) LTC/HTC facility is not available to retired Judicial officers, subject to clause (d).1
- f) The Judicial Officers shall not be required to avail of earned leave only, for LTC/HTC purpose and they are permitted to avail of casual leave as a prefix and suffix to the extent of two days.

Medical Allowance / Medical Facilities: XII.

- a) The Medical Allowance of Rs.3,000/- per month is admissible to the serving Judicial Officers with effect from 01.01.2016.
- b) Medical Allowance of Rs.4,000/- per month is admissible to the Pensioner Judicial Officers/Family Pension Holders with effect from 01.01.2016.
- c) The spouse or other dependents of Judicial Officers drawing Family Pension shall also be eligible for medical facilities / reimbursement at par with Pensioner of the Judiciary.
- d) The Judicial Officers are entitled for arrears accordingly.

Newspaper and Magazine Allowances: XIII.

- a) Reimbursement for newspaper and magazines shall be Rs.1000/- for District Judges (two newspapers and two magazines) and Rs.700/- for Civil Judges (two newspapers and one magazine).
- b) The reimbursement shall be on half yearly basis from January to June and July to December, on the basis of self-certification.
- c) The allowance at the above-mentioned rates shall be available from 01/01/2020.
- d) The Judicial Officers can opt to continue with existing facility OR to chance this mathed

XIV. Robe Allowance:

- a) An allowance of Rs 12,000/- is payable once in three years with effect from

Special Pay for Administrative Work

- a) Special Pay for Judicial officers doing administrative work shall be payable
 - (i) Principal District and Sessions Judges: Rs.7000/- per month
 - (ii) Other District Judges including I Additional District Judges entrusted with administrative work who have to generally spend time beyond Court working hours: Rs. 3500/- per month.
 - (iii)District Judges presiding over Special Courts and Tribunals having independent administrative responsibilities: Rs.3500/- per month.
 - (iv)CJMs and Principal Senior, Junior Civil Judges and other Judicial Officers having administrative responsibilities being in charge of independent Courts with filing powers: Rs.2000/- per month.
- b) The Special Pay is payable w.e.f. 01/01/2019 and Officers are entitled for arrears w.e.f 01/01/2019

IVX. Sumptuary Allowance:

- a) The Sumptuary Allowance to the Judicial Officers is enhanced at the following rates:
 - i. District Judges @ Rs. 7,800/- per month
 - Civil Judges(Sr.Div.) @ Rs. 5,800/- per month ii.
 - Civil Judges (Jr.Div.) @ Rs. 3,800/- per month iii.
- b) The allowance shall be available w.e.f. 01.01.2016 and Officers are entitled to claim difference amount w.e.f 01.01.2016
- c) The following categories of Judicial Officers shall get Rs.1,000/- (One thousand) more by virtue of their status or the additional responsibilities they shoulder.
 - Principal District Judge in-charge of administration (i) Districts/Cities. the
 - District Judges in selection grade and super time-scale. (ii)
 - Director of Judicial Academy/Judicial Training Institute/Member (iii) Secretary, State Legal Services Authority.
- Chief Judicial Magistrate/Chief Metropolitan Magistrate. (iv)
- d) No sumptuary allowance shall be payable to retired Judicial Officers.

Telephone Facility XVII.

- a) The Judicial Officers shall be provided with the following telephone facilities:
 - Residential Telephone (Landline):

The landline telephone and broadband facility (by the same or different service providers) shall be provided at the residence of the Judicial Officers with the permitted user as follows;

- (a) Obitici Judgos: Rs. 1500/- per month;

- (d) The Judicial Officers shall be given option to retain the old mobile phone handset at a price to be determined as per the guidelines prescribed by the Registry of High Court.
- (e) The existing facilities in so far as they are more beneficial shall be continued notwithstanding these orders.

c) Office Telephone: "

Regarding telephone connection to the office, the present arrangement shall continue.

XVIII. Transfer Grant:

- a) On transfer, the composite transfer grant shall be equivalent to one month's basic pay.
- b) If the transfer is to a place at a distance of 20 kilometres or less or within the same city, the transfer grant shall be 1/3rd of the basic pay, provided a change of residence is actually involved.
- c) For the transportation of personal effects, the O.M. dated 13.07.2017 (annexed as Appendix I) issued by the Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Government of India pursuant to the recommendations of VII CPC shall be applicable.
- d) In case of transportation by road, the admissible amount shall be Rs.50/per km. inclusive of labour charges for loading and unloading or the actual
 whichever is lower. The said amount shall be raised by 25% when the DA
 increases by 50%.
- e) This grant shall be payable with effect from 01.01.2016.
- f) The Officers who have undergone transfer(s) after 01.01.2016 and their claims for Transfer Grant paid as per pre-revised pay scales, shall be paid

FURNITURE AND AIR CONDITIONER ALLOWANCE: XIX.

- a) Furniture grant of Rs.1.25 lakhs every five years shall be provided to the Judicial Officer subject to production of proof of purchase. Household electrical appliances can also be purchased by availing of the said grant. The Officers having not less than two years of service are also eligible for this allowance. The option to purchase the furniture being used by the Officer at the depreciated rate decided by the High Court shall be available after expiry of five years of purchase or at the time of retirement.
- b) Apart from the furniture grant, one Air conditioner shall be provided at the residence of every Judicial Officer once in every five years.
- Orders will be issued separately in respect of House Rent Allowance and Residential Quarters, Medical Facilities and Reimbursement facilities to the Judicial Officers and Residential Quarters Maintenance.
- In respect of the claims of the Judicial Officers who retired or died while in service or after retirement relating to the allowances / grants / sanctioned in paras at 1 to 18 above for the periods they were in service subsequent to 01-01-2016 shall be submitted supported by necessary certificates to the Principal District Judges of the Districts / Heads of the Units in twin cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad and other places where they last worked or died while in service. The Principal District Judges of the Districts / Heads of the Units concerned shall draw and pay the arrears after scrutiny. In respect of claims relating to deceased Judicial Officers the claims shall be preferred by the Family Pensioners of such deceased officers to the Principal District Judges / Heads of the Units where the deceased officer last worked and the arrears shall be paid to them.
- The Registrar General (Admn), High Court for the State of Telangana, Hyderabad shall take necessary action accordingly.

Subject: Revision of Allowances of retired Judicial Officers/ Family Pensioners of the Tripura Judicial Service in compliance of the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 04.01.2024 in WP(C) No. 643 of 2015 (All India Judges Association Vs Union of India& Ors.)

In compliance of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in WP(C)No. 643 of 2015 in All India Judges Association Vs. Union of India and others dated 04-01-2023 for implementation of Second National Judicial Pay Commission (SNJPC) recommendations regarding Revision of allowances payable to the retired Judicial Officers/ Family Pensioners of District and Sub-ordinate Judiciary in the State, and in Supersession of all existing Notifications/Memos on this matter, the Governor of Tripura is pleased to accord sanction to implement the recommendations of Second National Judicial Pay Commission Recommendations as accepted by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and accordingly, pleased to order the following in respect of retired Judicial Officers/ Family Pensioners of Tripura Judicial Service viz;

A) EARNED LEAVE ENCASHMENT (w.e.f. 01.01.2016):

The retired Judicial Officers, ie., pensioners, shall be entitled to encash up to 300 days Earned Leave (EL) at the time of retirement. In case while granting leave encashment at the time of retirement, the leave encashment availed during service stand adjusted, shall be paid the amount of the so adjusted earned leave, at the time of retirement, within a period of 3(three) months.

B) DOMESTIC HELP ALLOWANCE (w.e.f. 01.01.2016):

- My 1.
 - 1. The Domestic Help Allowance to the pensioners and family pensioners shall be available at the following rates with effect from 01.01.2016:
 - (a) Pensioner Rs.9,000/- per month.
 - (b) Family Pensioners Rs.7,000/- per month.
 - 2. This allowance shall stand increased by 30% on completion of five years from 01.01.2016, i.e., w.e.f. 01.01.2021.

(C) MEDICAL ALLOWANCE (w.e.f. 01.01.2016) AND MEDICAL FACILITIES

- 1. Fixed medical allowance shall be payable @₹ 4,000/- per month to the pensioner and family pensioners with effect from 01.01.2016.
- 2. The spouse or other dependents of retired / deceased Judicial Officers, who are drawing family pension, shall also be eligible for medical facilities / re-imbursement at par with the pensioners of the Tripura Judicial Service.
- 3. (a) The District & Sessions Judges or Registry of the High Court [in respect of District & Sessions Judges] shall be empowered to address Credit letters to the concerned hospitals where the Judicial Pensioner/ Family Pensioner has been or to be admitted as inpatient.
- (b) For the pensioners and family pensioners, a medical card on the line of what is being issued in Delhi as shown in Appendix-I annexed herewith shall be issued by the District & Sessions Judge concerned.
- (c) In the case of emergency, Retired Judicial Officers as well as Family Pensioners can take treatment in any nearest private hospital, not necessarily a Govt. notified hospital and seek re-imbursement as per the usual procedure. If necessary, credit letter shall be issued for this purpose.
- 4. On submission of the estimate given by the recognized/ empanelled hospital, 80% shall be sanction as advance, subject to preliminary scrutiny by the District & Sessions Judge or a District Judge (Grade-I Officer) of equivalent rank authorized by the Registry of the High Court. The balance shall be re-imbursed on certification by the designated civil surgeon or official of the Directorate of Medical and Health Services as the case may be. If the Govt. approved rates are not available for any particular item, the certifying officer shall have due regard to the rates generally charged in the hospitals concerned. Though there needs to be scrutiny before sanctioning the payment in view of the tendency to exaggerate the estimates, the extent of disallowance shall be disclosed by the certifying authority. The bills send by the District Judge for scrutiny of the designated civil surgeon/ officer of Health Directorate shall be cleared within a maximum period of one month from the date of receipt.
- My
- 5. The retired Judicial Officers and the Family Pensioners who have settled down in another State shall have the facility to claim medical re-imbursement/ advance from the State from which she/ he is drawing pension/ family pension.
- 6. The cost of treatment including room charges/ test undergone in any Govt. / Govt. Notified/ recognized hospitals/ pathological labs in an emergency or otherwise shall be re-imbursed to the pensioners/ family pensioners who have settled in another State after retirement even though such hospital or lab is not recognized in the State of Tripura.



- 7. The Registry of the High Court shall examine whether the notified/empanelled hospitals sufficiently cater to the needs of the Pensioners/ Family Pensioners of Tripura Judicial Service and send proposal to the State Government in the Health & Family Welfare Department for notifying additional hospitals/pathological labs to the extent it is considered necessary.
- 8. All medical facilities including cashless medical facilities as recommended by the SNJPC and as approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court to which the retired Judicial Officers including their spouses and other dependents/ family pensioners are entitled to, can be availed in the Hospitals currently empanelled under the Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS).

The Pension Disbursing Authorities shall be deemed to be authorised to make payment of arrears on accounts of the revision of the allowances under this notification, immediately after adjusting the amounts already paid in the pre-revised rates, and the amount of revised allowances shall be paid with the revised pension/ family pension. The Pension Disbursing Authorities are hereby authorised to comply the above, without waiting for any further notification/memo/order from the State Government, as this notification is issued with the concurrence of the State Government in the Finance Department.





उपर्युक्त विषयक मा० उच्चतम न्यायालय, नई दिल्ली में योजित रिट याचिका सं0—643/2015 ऑल इण्डिया जजेस एसोसियेशन बनाम भारत संघ व अन्य में पारित आदेश दिनांक 04.01.2024 के क्रम में मुझे यह कहने का निदेश हुआ है कि मा० उच्चतम न्यायालय द्वारा पारित उक्त आदेश के अनुपालन में राज्य के समस्त न्यायिक अधिकारियों के भत्ते निम्नलिखित दरों के अनुसार पुनरीक्षित किये जाने की श्री राज्यपाल सहर्ष स्वीकृति प्रदान करते हैं:—

1- भवन निर्माण/क्रय/मरम्मत भत्ता-

प्रत्येक न्यायिक अधिकारी को भवन—निर्माण/क्रय/मरम्मत हेतु अग्रिम धनराशि की सुविधा केन्द्र सरकार के कार्मिकों के समान इस परिवर्तन के साथ अनुमन्य होगी कि न्यायिक अधिकारी द्वारा निजी व्यक्तियों से भी भवन क्रय किया जा सकेगा, किन्तु निजी व्यक्तियों से किये जाने वाले सम्व्यवहार के ओवर इस्टीमेशन की जाँच/Check करने के लिए मा0 उच्च न्यायालय के द्वारा गठित समिति की सलाह के अनुसार राज्य सरकार द्वारा नियम प्रख्यापित किये जायेंगे।

- (क) चाईल्ड एजुकेशन एलाउन्स-रू० 2,250/-प्रतिमाह
- (ख) होस्टल सब्सिडी-रू० 6,750/- प्रतिमाह
