Outstanding 1110 numbers of UC to the tune of ₹4299 crore by Government Departments

Shillong, November 14: Many departments of the State Government could not submit 1110 numbers of Utilization Certificate (UC) amounting to ₹4299.62 crore.

“ At the close of March 2019 accounts, 1110 UCs amounting to ₹4299.62 crore remained outstanding in the books of the Pr. Accountant General (A&E) Meghalaya” stated the report of Comptroller & Auditor General of India in the State Finance Audit Report of the year ending 31 March 2019.

As per the report, major defaulting departments who have not submitted UCs are Education Department ₹1757.25 crore (40.87 %), Economic Service Department ₹532.87 crore (12.39%), Rural Employment Department ₹506.06 crore (11.77%), Rural Development Department ₹424.50 crore (9.87%), Health & Family Welfare Department ₹410.79 crore (9.55%) Welfare of Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes Department ₹273.30 crore (6.36%), Power Department ₹123.55 crore (2.87%), Arts and Culture Department ₹76.78 crore (1.79 %), Social Security & Welfare Department ₹58.83 crore (1.37%) and Sports & Youth Affairs Department ₹45.24 crore (1.05%).

“To the extent of non-receipt of UCs, the expenditure cannot be treated as final nor can it be confirmed that the amount has been utilised for the intended purpose” stated the report in remark to the outstanding UCs which could lead to diversion of funds for other purposes.

At the same time, the CAG's report had advised the State Government on the need to lay down stringent conditions regarding fixation of timeline for submission of UCs and in case of failure, stern actions to be taken. The report also stated that something should also be done concerning the irresponsible Officers.
