

**Minutes of Departmental Screening Committee meeting for consideration of cases for Compassionate Appointment for year 2022**

The Departmental Screening Committee (D.S.C.) consisting of Shri Rajendra Kumar Khare, Sr. Deputy Accountant General (Admn.), office of the Principal Accountant General (A&E)-I, Uttar Pradesh, Prayagraj, Shri Jay Prakash, Sr. Deputy Accountant General (A.M.G.-III/Admn), office of the Principal Accountant General (Audit)-II, Uttar Pradesh, Lucknow and Ms. Dhanlaxmi Chourasia, Sr. Deputy Accountant General (A.M.G.-II), office of the Principal Accountant General (Audit)-I, Uttar Pradesh, Prayagraj met on **07.04.2022** to assess the necessity and suitability of the candidates for appointment on compassionate grounds as per the Scheme of Compassionate Appointment.

2. The Committee was informed that 5% of the vacancies in Group 'C' cadre arising during the year for compassionate appointment for the calendar year 2022 has been earmarked **2.70 (rounded to 03)** as on 01.01.2022.
3. The Committee was informed that **29** deferred cases of previous years and **23** fresh cases received from dependents of deceased employees since the last DSC meeting, are to be considered for compassionate appointment. The List of **total 52** cases is placed as **Annexure 'A'**. Which is to be considered by DSC for compassionate appointment.
4. The appointment under the scheme for compassionate appointment is regulated as per instructions issued by Govt. of India, Deptt. of Personnel & Training O.M. No. F.No.14014/02/2012-Estt.(D) dated 16.01.2013, O.M. No. F.No.43019/9/2019-Estt.(D) dated 23.08.2021, Headquarter Circular No. 34 letter No.09-Staff Entt. (Rules)/C.A/12-2015 dated 28.09.2016 and other supplementary instructions issued on the subject by the Headquarters' office from time to time.
5. On scrutiny of records of candidates, the Committee analyzed the necessity and suitability of all the applicants on the basis of information/documents provided by Administration and by the candidates. The grading is placed at **Annexure 'A'**.
6. Taking into consideration the objective of the scheme and extant rules relating to appointment on compassionate grounds and after assessing the financial condition of the families, the DSC found that **Smt. Anita Devi** w/o Late Jitendra Kumar, Ex-Clerk, **Shri Anshul Yadav**, b/o Late Manish Yadav, Ex. Sr. Accountant and **Shri Utkarsh Kumar Raj**, s/o Late Anil Kumar, Ex. Clerk have obtained highest marks as per model evaluation system.
