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Minutes of the Departmental Screening Committee (DSC) held for consideration of appointment on compassionate ground during the panel year 2022 in the office of the Principal Accountant General (A&E), Manipur, Imphal.

In terms of para 13 (c) of DoPT's OM No. 14014/02/2012-Estt (D) dated 16/01/2013, a Departmental Screening Committee is constituted with the approval of the Competent Authority vide order dated 19/09/2022 consisting of Shri Hautinlal Suantak, Sr. Deputy Accountant General (Audit), O/o the Pr. Accountant General, Mizoram as Chairman, Shri D. Anish, Sr. Deputy Accountant General (A&E), O/o the Accountant General (A&E), Meghalaya as Member and Shri Robert Moirangthem, Sr. Deputy Accountant General (A&E), O/o the Pr. Accountant General (A&E), Manipur as Member, to consider the cases of appointment on compassionate ground during the year 2022 in the office of the Pr. Accountant General (A&E), Manipur.

2. The Committee was informed that by following consolidated instructions on compassionate appointment issued vide DoPTs O.M. No. F. No. 14014/02/201-Estt. (D) Dated 16.01.2013, and subsequent OM No. 14014/1/2022-Estt (D) dated 02/08/2022 –Master Circular on scheme of compassionate appointment, 5% of the total vacancy in the Gr-'C' cadres meant for compassionate appointment is worked out cadre-wise as on 01.01.2022, as under:



3. The Committee was informed that the vacancies for compassionate appointment calculated at 5% of Gr-'C' posts in DR Quota arrived at 2.52, which is rounded off to 3 (three).

4. The Committee was informed that there were six applications for compassionate appointment as on 30th June 2022.




The Committee was informed that verification on the family and financial conditions of the family members of the deceased Government servant was carried out by the Welfare Officer (Sr. AO-Admn.), thereby recording statement of each individual applicant at their respective residences. After going through the verification reports of the Welfare Officer in respect of all the six candidates, the following observations/ recommendations are made:

Accountant General (A&E), Manipur.</p> <p>Though the applicant is recommended FIT by the Committee, the case may be forwarded to HQs for approval as required in terms of para 4 of HQs letter No. 130-Staff Entt. Khuplianmang, Ex- Accountant [UARN- K203708M220412002]</p>	<p>As per the verification report of the Welfare Officer (Sr. AO-Admn.) and other information available in this office, the DSC observed the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The educational qualification of the applicant is Matric/HSLC, and as such he is eligible for appointment to the Gr-'C' post of Multi-Tasking Staff (MTS). 2. The wife of the deceased Govt. employee is a Primary Teacher working in the Autonomous District Council (ADC), Chandel, Manipur, drawing monthly gross salary of ₹ 61,000/- approx. 3. There are four dependent family members (wife of the deceased employee, one daughter and two sons including the applicant). Of the four family members, daughter of the deceased Govt. employee got married. The applicant and his major brother are living with their Uncle, since they have no house of their own to live in. 4. Neither the applicant nor his brother is employed in any Govt. or Private Sector. 5. The family of the deceased Govt. employee had received ₹ 8,33,041/- as pensionary benefits. The Committee also noted that the wife of the deceased employee who is presently working in the ADC, Chandel (now Head Mistress of School) is retiring in four years (on 28.02.2026) and there is no other earning member in the family till today. Further, the total meagre assets left by the deceased employee at the time of his death may not hold the family's financial conditions stably to lead a healthy life in the</p>

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

The Committee also took note of the marks (90/165) obtained by the applicant, based on point based merit system Further, the conditions mentioned at paras 11 (a) and 13 (xi) & (xii) of DoPT's OM F. No. 14041/1/2022-Estt. (D) dated 02/08/2022 on 'Master Circular on Compassionate' has also been kept in mind while considering this case. Hence, the applicant is considered to be deserving for appointment on compassionate ground..</p> <p>Accordingly, the Committee found Shri T. Muanminthang "FIT" for appointment to the post of MTS on compassionate ground in the office of the Pr. Accountant General (A&E), Manipur, Imphal.</p> <p>Though the applicant is recommended FIT by the Committee, the case may be forwarded to HQs for approval as required in terms of para 4 of HQs letter No. 130-Staff Entt. (Rules)/A.R./02-2021 dated 24/08/2022.</p>

The educational qualification of the applicant is Master of Arts, and as such she is eligible for appointment to the Gr- 'C' post of Accountant/ Clerk/ MTS. 2. There are four dependent family members [(husband of the deceased employee, two daughters (including the applicant) and one son (got married))]. 3. The husband of the deceased Govt. employee was an employee in SBI and now retired, drawing pension of ₹ 26,750/- per month. In addition to his own pension, he is in receipt of family pension at enhanced rate of ₹ 36050/- (the amount of ₹ 36050/- will be reduced to ₹ 21630/- per month after 10 years from the date of death of the employee) in respect of the deceased Govt. employee. 4. Further, the son of the deceased Govt. employee is working in UCO Bank at Churachandpur Branch, Manipur and living separately with his family. 5. None of the daughters of the deceased Govt. employee are employed in any Govt. or Private Sector. 6. The family of the deceased Govt. employee had received ₹ 39,99,217/- as pensionary benefits. Other than these amounts, the family owns a plot of land measuring 0.113 acres of revenue land valued at ₹ 1,50,000/-, a residential house valued ₹ 20,19,916/- at New Lamka, Churachandpur, Manipur and a Grand i10 Car. <p>The Committee, after taking into consideration all the parameters, such as existence of two dependent family members (excluding son and husband of the deceased employee, but including the applicant), the fact that the family</p>



Accordingly, the Committee has found Miss Dimgelching "UNFIT" for appointment on compassionate ground in terms of para 19 (b) (iii) of DoPT's OM dated 02/08/2022 , and her case may be treated as 'closed'.</p>

The educational qualification of the applicant is 12th Science (with Mathematics), and as such he is eligible for appointment to the Gr- 'C' post of DEO- 'A' / Clerk/ MTS. 2. There are four dependent family members [(wife of the deceased employee, two sons (the applicant and one minor son) and sister of the deceased Govt. employee)]. 3. However, none of the family members of the deceased Govt. employee are employed in any Govt. or Private Sector. 4. The family of the deceased Govt. employee had received ₹ 26,09,279/- as pensionary benefits. Other than these amounts, the family owns a plot of land measuring 0.15 acres valued at ₹ 15,00,000/-, situated at Motbung Village which falls under the Chieftainship of Village Authority. <p>The Committee after taking into consideration all the parameters, such as existence of four wholly dependent family members (including one minor), the fact that enhanced family pension at ₹ 23100/- will be reduced to ₹ 13860/- per month after 10 years from the date of death of the employee, the pension being the only source of income for livelihood, and the assets owned by the family members of the deceased employee (which appears to be insufficient to hold the family in long run), is of the view that the applicant is needy of appointment on compassionate ground.</p> <p>The Committee also took note of the marks (100/165) obtained by the applicant, based on point-based merit system.</p> <p>Accordingly, the Committee found Shri Paogaouhao Lhouvum "FIT" for appointment on compassionate ground to the Gr-'C' post of Clerk in the office of the Pr. Accountant General</p>

The educational qualification of the applicant is Matriculation/ HSCL (10th), and as such he is eligible for appointment to the Gr- 'C' post of MTS. 2. There are seven dependent family members [(wife of the deceased employee, four sons (including the applicant) and two daughters (one divorced)]. 3. None of the family members of the deceased Govt. employee are employed in any Govt. or Private Sector. 4. The family of the deceased Govt. employee had received ₹ 19,62,849/- as pensionary benefits. Other than these amounts, the family owns a plot of land measuring 0.11 acres valued at ₹ 5,00,000/- situated in Lilong which falls under the Revenue Village No. 16 and a residential house valued ₹ 26,06,000/-. <p>Re-verification on the family conditions of the deceased employee was again conducted on 28/11/2022 which revealed that Md. Islauddin (the applicant) was arrested by the Thoubal Police on 16/10/2022 in connection with the murder of his brother (Md. Muzibur Rahaman) and now he is in Jail.</p> <p>Accordingly, the Committee is of the view that consideration for appointment of Md. Islauddin, s/o late Md. None of the family members of the deceased Govt. employee are employed in any Govt. or Private Sector. 4. The family of the deceased Govt. employee had received ₹ 38,36,235/- as pensionary benefits. Other than these amounts, the family owns a plot of land measuring 0.57 acres of land valued at ₹ 5,00,000/- situated at Khurkhul Village No. 38, and a residential house valued ₹ 38,29,551/- <p>The Committee after taking into consideration all the parameters, such as existence of five dependent family</p>

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
