**PROCEEDINGS OF THE DEPARTMENTAL SCREENING COMMITTEE FOR
APPOINTMENT ON COMPASSIONATE GROUND FOR THE YEAR 2024.**

The Departmental Screening Committee comprising Ms. Sumedha Amar, Sr. Deputy Accountant General (Administration & AMG-V), O/o the Principal Accountant General (Audit), Haryana, Chandigarh, Shri Ranjeet Singh, Sr. Deputy Accountant General (Admn), O/o the Principal Accountant General (A&E), Haryana, Chandigarh and Sh. Gutte Rohit Manikrao, Deputy Accountant General (AMG-III), O/o the Principal Accountant General (Audit), Haryana, Chandigarh held its meeting on 22.08.2024 to consider the following cases for appointment on compassionate ground:-

2. The Committee was informed that Govt. of India, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Department of Personnel and Training, New Delhi vide F.No. 14014/01/2022-Estt. (D) Dated 02.08.2022 has consolidated the earlier instructions on the Scheme for Compassionate Appointment under Central Government by including contents of all the important/relevant O.Ms issued till date.

3. The committee noticed that the basic objective of the scheme is to grant appointments on compassionate grounds to a dependent family member of a Govt. Servant who died in harness or retired on medical grounds thereby leaving his/her family without any means of livelihood and to relieve the family concerned from financial destitution and to help it get over the emergency. Meaning thereby that the basic criteria for the appointment must be to ascertain whether the death or retirement on medical grounds of the Govt. Servant, had left the family in financial destitution and penury without any means of livelihood.

4. The Committee was informed that 05-vacancies **(02-in DEO, 01-in Clerk and 02-in MTS cadre)** in Group 'C' cadre for compassionate appointment during the year 2024 are available.

5. The committee was apprised that three (03) applications for compassionate appointment for the year 2023 were not recommended by the earlier DSC held on 18.12.2023, however, Principal Accountant General has taken a sympathetic view on these cases and vide orders dated 13.05.2024 has directed, to reconsider these cases along with the 02 fresh cases for the year 2024 but as no new facts/information was found in 03 cases viz. Ms. Vinita Pundeer D/o Late Shri Govind Singh, Ex. Asstt. Supervisor, Ms. Sanjana Kumari D/o late Shri Rajbir Singh, Ex. Asstt. Supervisor and Shri Sumit Kumar Singh S/o Late Shri Devta Deen. Hence, committee is of the view that the recommendations of the previous committee are in order. Thus, the committee does not recommend these 03 cases for appointment under compassionate ground in O/o Principal Accountant General (Audit), Haryana, Chandigarh. Further, two (02) new cases are pending for appointment on compassionate ground for the year 2024. The brief of these cases is as follows: -

(a) Shri Saurav Dogra S/o Late Shri Balbir Singh, Sr. Auditor.

Smt. Renu Bala w/o late Shri Balbir Singh, Sr. Auditor has applied on 07.07.2023, for appointment of her Son Shri Saurav Dogra on compassionate ground. The deceased Shri Balbir Singh, Sr. Auditor joined the department on 25.02.2000 and died on 14.06.2023. The remaining service left at the time of death was 8 years 8 month 15 days. Further, as per report of the Sr. AO Welfare, Late Shri Balbir Singh, Sr. Auditor left behind 01 daughter of 18 years old and 01 Son of 21 years old. The applicant is having 12th passed and currently unemployed and residing in Government Accommodation at House No. 1506A, Sector-41/B, Chandigarh. Further, the family of the deceased have received the total terminal benefits of Rs. 15,62,282/- and GPF of Rs. 2,18,754/- as under:

- i. DCRG of Rs. 13,42,326/-,
- ii. Leave encashment – Rs.86,571/-
- iii. CGEGIS – Rs. 73,385/-,
- iv. DLIS- Rs. 60,000/-
- v. GPF- Rs. 2,18,754/-
- vi. Family pension-Rs. 20550/-+DA per month (enhanced rate up to 14.06.2033) thereafter, at normal rate i.e Rs. 12330/- + DA.

The deceased of the family owns parental Property in Village- Kuthar, Tehsil-Shahpur, Distt-Kangra, Himachal Pradesh, at cost of Rs. 1,94,680.

As per bank pass book of Smt. Renu Bala (Account No. 30933383091 of SBI) there was a closing balance of Rs. 217546.82/- on 30.10.2023 and Shri Saurav Dogra (Account No. 39685521673 of SBI) has a closing balance of Rs. 2314.05/-).

As is evident from above that the family of the deceased officials have received a terminal benefit of only Rs.15,62,282/- and have no other source of livelihood except monthly pension @ Rs 12330/- (normal rate) plus DA per month. Further, the family has no bank balance and has 01 daughter and 01 son.

Thus it is clear that the family of the deceased has been left in financial destitution and penury without any means of livelihood. Hence, the Committee recommends the case of Shri Saurav Dogra S/o Late Shri Balbir Singh, Sr. Auditor, for appointment under compassionate grounds in office of the Principal Accountant General (Audit) Haryana, Chandigarh.

(b) Smt. Preeti W/o late Shri Arshdeep Singh, Auditor:

Smt Preeti W/o Late Shri Arshdeep Singh, Auditor has applied for appointment of herself on compassionate ground. The deceased have joined the department on 05.03.2015 and died while in service on 12.07.2023. The remaining service left at the time of death was 30 years 5 months. The deceased left behind 02 daughters aged 05 years and 04 years. The applicant is having BCA and currently unemployed and residing at House No. MIG 2211, Sector-66, Mohali.

Further, the family of the deceased have received the total terminal benefits of Rs.5,85,735/ as under:

- i. DCRG of Rs. 5,43,576/-,
- ii. Leave encashment – Rs. 9,613/-
- iii. CGEGIS – Rs. 32,546/-,
- iv. Family pension- Rs. 15950/-+DA per month (enhanced rate up to 12.07.2033) thereafter, at normal rate i.e Rs. 9570/-+DA

As per bank pass book of Smt. Preeti (Account No. 00000041844282310 of SBI) closing balance of Rs. 28422.87/- on 31.01.2024. In addition, Late Shri Arshdeep Singh, had taken a personal loan of Rs. 10,00,000/- from SBI Bank which has not been paid yet, this amount has increased to Rs. 12,16,504/- for repayment. They have one Car and do not have any other moveable or immovable property in his name or that of his dependent child or spouse in Chandigarh or anywhere in India except the ancestral house (value Approx. 65 Lakh) in the name of his Father-in-law in which her late husband has 25% stake (Approx. 16.25 Lakh).

As is evident from above that the family of the deceased officials have received a terminal benefit of Rs. 5.85.735/- and monthly pension of Rs. 9570/ plus DA (normal rate) per month. At the time of death of the official, the remaining service left was 30 years 5 months.

Thus it is clear that the family of the deceased has been left in financial destitution and penury without any means of livelihood. Hence, the Committee recommends the case of Smt. Preeti W/o Late Shri Arshdeep Singh, Auditor, for appointment under compassionate grounds in office of the Principal Accountant General (Audit) Haryana, Chandigarh.

6. The committee after evaluation of the financial position of the family of deceased government servant, as per possession of requisite qualification as required under Recruitment Rules for the relevant posts and as per the total points obtained by each applicants, under the applicable point-based merit system as shown in Annexure- 'V (ii)' recommended as follows:
