

CHAPTER 8: MONITORING

The District Development Commissioner is responsible for monitoring the progress of implementation of various developmental programmes undertaken in the District, including all the Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS). The State Government has also given priority to the monitoring and physical verification of all the developmental schemes including CSS. For effective monitoring, the State Government created (June 2006) the post of Additional District Developmental Commissioners at District levels. He is to tour intensively along with departmental officers to carry out monitoring and physical verification of all the developmental schemes for at least 15 days during a month.

Records showed that the District authorities had reviewed and monitored only construction works taken up in the District. The implementation of the flagship programmes such as NRHM, SSA, ARWSP, SJSRY, waste management etc. had not been monitored by the authorities. Besides, the District authorities had not toured adequately to monitor all schemes for at least 15 days during the month. The Additional District Development Commissioner stated (April 2011) that the implementation of CSS had also been monitored and the inspection reports thereof had been kept separately. No such records were, however, produced to Audit.
